

VENUE, ACCESS, FACILITIES AND TRANSPORT

Overview

WOC 2023 will take place in Flims Laax / Switzerland. Flims Laax is located in the canton of Graubünden, 130 km south-east of Zurich and can be reached by train and bus in 2 hours 20 minutes from Zurich Airport.

The athletes' village and the Event Office are located in Laax Murschetg at «rocksresort».

Competition Arenas

The finish arena for all three final races is in the **Prau la Selva sports centre** in Flims, which can be reached on foot in 15 minutes from Laax Murschetg or from Flims village. GPS coordinates: 46.82382, 9.27600



The finish arena for the Middle Distance Qualification race is in Trin Mulin GPS coordinates: 46.82373, 9.32724.

Facilities in the finish arenas

In the finish arena for the middle distance qualification we will provide tents for changing your clothes. Teams are allowed to bring their own tents. Drinking water is provided. Toilets on site. You can buy a coffee, beverages and small snacks.

In the finish arena for the finals the after finish zone is in a covered area, no team tents allowed. Changing rooms, showers, toilets and drinking water are available after the individual finals. Small outdoor zone for cool-down. Toilets are available in the relay (changing rooms and showers only after the last finish). A wide range of Swiss food will be available.

Facilities in the quarantines

All quarantines for the individual races will be indoor with toilets, changing rooms and drinking water. Good possibilities for outdoor warm up on a map on the way to the pre-start.

The quarantine for the relay will be a covered area with toilets. Small outdoor zone for warm up and cool-down running (no map).

No team tents allowed in any of the quarantines.

Transport / Travel services

We highly recommend travelling to Flims Laax by train and bus as you don't need a car to get around at **WOC 2023 - the WOC of short distances!** From the athletes' village and from Flims, all model events, races, ceremonies and shopping facilities can be reached quickly and easily on foot, by bike or by the free shuttle bus in less than 15 minutes. We therefore recommend everyone to travel here by public transport!

Compulsory transport to quarantines will be organized for the teams in all individual competitions. To the relay quarantine you have to walk from the athletes' village.

Non-competing athletes and coaches heading to the Middle Distance Qualification arena take the shuttle bus to the finish or their own cars. Transport back to the athletes' village from the Middle Distance Qualification finish arena will be organized for the teams with shuttle busses. It is allowed to bring your own car to Trin Mulin (there is a signed parking for teams and staff). Non-competing athletes and coaches heading to the finish arena of the finals walk from the athletes' village to the finish arena. A map with the allowed route choices will be provided in Bulletin 4.

The finish arena of all the final races is within walking distance of the athletes' village. We will provide transport for the teams' equipment.

WOC 2023

No parking in the finish arena (parking is in the athletes' village in rocksresort).

All guests of Flims Laax Falera will receive a tourist card for the days of your stay which allows free use of the official shuttle busses between the three villages of Flims – Laax – Falera. The bus will run at least every 15 minutes during daytime.

How to get to Flims Laax

By **train and bus** from Zurich Airport to Flims Laax: the journey will take 2h 20min and runs every 30 min in daytime. From the airport you take the train to Zurich Main Station and to Chur and change there to the bus towards Flims Laax. The ticket costs approx. CHF 60.- one way p.p. Information, timetable and online tickets at: www.sbb.ch/en

On request we will organize a **shuttle service** from/to Zurich airport. This journey takes approx. 2h (depending on traffic) and will cost between CHF 35.- to 80.- one way per person depending on the size of the bus booked. Booking this shuttle service must be done by 25 May 2023 by email to info@woc2023.ch.

By **car** from Zurich: Take the A3 highway until exit 18 "Reichenau" and follow road 19 up to Flims Laax. Depending on the traffic, the journey will take between 1h 45min and 2h 45min (during the main traffic hours). Parking is possible in the parking garage of rocksresort (CHF 15.– per day).

WOC Welcome Desk

From Saturday, 08.07.2023 to Sunday, 09.07.2023 a WOC Welcome Desk will be open where you can obtain your room key, the training maps and answers to your questions.

Accreditation

The accreditation will be possible on Monday, 10.07.2023 and Tuesday, 11.07.2023. All athletes must attend in person in order to obtain their accreditation. All athletes need to show their passport and have their photo taken as part of the accreditation process. These photos will be used for the following purposes:

- Their athlete profile on woc2023.app
- Interactive start/result lists with links to your athlete profile
- Social media posts connected to WOC 2023
- Stories/photos connected to WOC 2023 on woc2023.app / woc2023.ch
- Media archive

You can download your profile photo to use freely for your own social media posts, for example. If possible, all members of the respective teams should attend the accreditation process together so that the accreditation process will be easier to handle for the organizer. Please book your team's accreditation time in advance so that you will not have to wait in the queue. You can book your team accreditation time from 01.07.2023 on the woc2023.app/teams website.

Event-Stage and Medal Plaza

All ceremonies will take place on our medal plaza on the "Piazza" of the rocksresort.

Team Officials Meetings

The Team Officials Meetings (TOM) will be held in Peaks Place (in room "Piz Fess II"). Please note that there will be a combined TOM for the Middle Final and Relay on Friday 14th July.

Farewell Party

The farewell party for all team members will take place in the Riders' Club (in the rocksresort). Only accredited team members will have access to the party so please bring your WOC accreditation.





REGISTRATION

Team Registration, Entry Fee

Accreditation fee: CHF 120.- per person (athletes and officials) includes start fee (for athletes), transport to competitions, entry to the farewell party and accommodation (according to the conditions below).

All entries can only be made in IOF Eventor. Accommodation in the athletes' village must be booked by email to nils.eyer@woc2023.ch by the Team Size Entry deadline of 12 May 2023. Your accommodation preferences cannot be guaranteed.

The entry is open in IOF Eventor: https://eventor.orienteering.org/Events/Show/6496

 The deadline for team size entry is 12 May 2023 (-2 months). Free accommodation can only be booked by this deadline of 12 May 2023. For bookings after this deadline, the accommodation must be paid according to the prices stipulated in the Accommodation section of Bulletin 2. If the number of team members is reduced after this deadline, the surplus beds will be charged extra according to the prices stipulated in the Accommodation section of Bulletin 2 (even if the final number of members is lower than the number of team accommodation offered for free).

- The deadline for Team Names Entry is 2 July 2023 (-10 days).
- The deadline for Late Entries, Changes of Team Size or Team Names for accreditation is 11 July 2023 at 12:00 noon.

The Team Size Entry must include the following information:

- Name of the team manager (chosen from the list in IOF Eventor) with e-mail address and mobile phone number (must be filled in on the IOF Eventor list).
- Number of team athletes men and women.
- Number of team officials (there is no limit to the number of team officials).
- Preferred accommodation within the package offered or announce waiver of the offer if you are looking for your own accommodation (should be sent by e-mail).

The Team Names Entry must include the following information:

- Name of each athlete selected from federation members in IOF Eventor (note that all participating athletes need to have an athlete's licence)
- Name of each team official

Late entries, changes of team size or names:

- If possible, will be accepted until 11 July 2023, 12:00 noon. No entries or changes will be accepted after this deadline.
- A defined extra fee will always be charged on the accreditation fee (surcharge, see scheme below).
- Extra costs for the accommodation connected with late entries or changes will be charged.
- They will be treated equally and must be communicated directly to the organizer on info@woc2023.ch if you can't make the change yourself in IOF Eventor anymore.

Competition entries, National Quota

Names of the competitors and, if required, their starting group must be entered in IOF Eventor before 12:00 noon on the day before the Middle Qualification race and before 15:00 on the day before the Long Distance. The names of Relay team members and their running order for the relay must be entered in IOF Eventor before 17:00 on Saturday, 15 July 2023.

Number of team athletes in the individual competitions: The national quotas, including the additional starting places for WOC 2023 are published on the IOF website in the "National Quota for FootO WOC and World Cup 2023" document.

Number of teams for the relays: one team per nation in both the women's and men's relay.

Registration for IOF Family

Your accreditation fee as an **IOF Family Member** is CHF 80.-*. This includes:

- 3-day-ticket to the finish arena (finals)**
- Admission to the IOF Family area with services at the event arena
- Drinks and snacks at the arena
- Competition maps

* If you are entered for the Swiss O Week, you can get an additional CHF 30.– discount on the IOF Family Member Accreditation fee since you already have the 3-day-ticket to the finish arena. When registering (see below), select "Save and order services" and then select "Discount for participants in the Swiss O week". This gives you a CHF 30.– discount.

** Discounted standing room only tickets in the IOF Family tent. Separate tickets for seating in the grandstand.

IOF Family Dinner on Friday, 14 July from 19:00 in Flims Laax: CHF 50.- This includes:

 Dinner buffet (starter, main course, dessert), one welcome drink and tap water (other beverages and drinks must be paid separately)

IOF Family and Media Race on Friday 14 July from 13:30 to 15:30 in Laax (rocksresort): CHF 10.-

All registrations for IOF Family Accreditation, IOF Family Dinner and IOF Family Race must be made in IOF Eventor. Which group to enter and how to get an IOF Eventor account is described in the IOF Family invitation document in the WOC 2023 page in IOF Eventor.


It will be possible to make any payments for last minute changes at the Event Office by credit card or in cash.

Accreditation

The accreditation process takes place at the WOC Event Office (see page 12). Although the accreditation process must be carried out by a Team Official, all registered competitors must also be present at accreditation to have their photo taken (see page 12) and to verify their identity by presenting their passport (or other officially recognised identity document accepted in Switzerland). A personal WOC ID card with photo will be provided on accreditation. All accredited persons must wear this WOC ID card at all relevant times and present it in order to access official WOC transport and authorized zones. The online entry through IOF Eventor requires that all persons to be accredited must provide a personal portrait photo for use on the ID card.

Participation in WOC events is only possible if all outstanding payments are made by 12:00 noon on 11 July 2023 at the latest.





ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

Accommodation for Teams

The same conditions apply for everyone: The Organizing Committee together with the Flims Laax Falera tourism organization invite you to stay in our athletes' village for free!

Every national team (3 women, 3 men and 2 coaches) is invited to stay from Tuesday, 11 July to Monday, 17 July 2023 in the athletes' village. For a detailed description of the accommodation options, please see Bulletin 2.

Teams will only pay the accreditation fee (CHF 120.- per person), the tourism taxes (CHF 5.- per night and person) and the accommodation for extra members and extra days (see prices in Bulletin 2). Of course, any additional services ordered must be paid for too.

Please indicate your preferred accommodation and make sure your payment reaches us at the latest by the Team Size Entry deadline. After this deadline and if you have not paid the accreditation fee, you must pay the full price for the accommodation according to the prices stipulated below. Training

WOC 2023

There are a lot of relevant and interesting training maps in the region around Flims Laax as well as in other parts of Switzerland. With the relevant local authorities, we have defined and agreed on access times for orienteering technique training locations. Therefore, all such training activities must be coordinated with the organizer and must be registered.

All training areas (with the allowed time periods) and the registration of the training activities can be found on the event website:

https://woc2023.app/woc2023/teams/training For each agreed orienteering training session you will pay a session fee of CHF 3.- per athlete per session. There is no extra fee for the OCAD files (see term of use of the ordered OCAD files on the website).

The training maps are also available during the whole WOC 2023 week until 16 July 2023.

Prior to and during the WOC 2023 week, it should be noted that the official accommodation is located close to the embargoed areas. Teams are responsible for adhering to and respecting the embargoed areas. At the WOC 2023 event centre, all team members will receive an overview map of the athletes' village with the borders of the embargoed areas clearly marked. This overview map will also indicate where jogging and running training is possible.

The model events will be available from Saturday, 8 July. As they are all within walking distance of the event centre, no transportation will be needed, and no on-site parking is available.

WOC competitors are allowed to participate in the first stage of the Swiss O Week on Sunday, 16 July 2023. Registration for the Challenge and Holiday categories must be made no later than the day before via the Swiss O Week website. Similarly, all training maps of the Swiss O Week may be used throughout the week of WOC 2023. These maps can be purchased at the WOC 2023 event office.

GPS-tracking during training sessions: If you wish to track your team athletes during orienteering training sessions, please be aware that the 2G technology no longer works in Switzerland. We recommend that you check with your provider whether your GPS tracker works with 3G or 4G.

RULES AND OTHER RELATED INFORMATION

Competition Rules

The competition rules for IOF Foot Orienteering Events 2023 will apply.

Please refer to the competition rules on the IOF website: https://orienteering.sport/orienteering/ competition-rules/

According to the Swiss Orienteering Competition Rule (WO Art. 54.2.c), it is forbidden to run with spike shoes in Switzerland. However, Dobb spikes and normal orienteering shoes are allowed.

Classes and Entry Regulations

Classes: WOMEN and MEN without any age restrictions (IOF Competition Rule § 5.7.). All competitors represent a federation (§ 6.5.). All athletes shall be citizens of the country they are representing (§ 6.1.).



Doping is strictly forbidden, and the organizers of WOC 2023 are dedicated to support the Anti-Doping Authorities in their work. Doping controls may be carried out any time during the event in accordance with the procedures described in the WADA International Standard of Testing and Investigations. The IOF Anti-Doping Rules and the World Anti-Doping Code apply.

Insurance

The event organizers will not be liable in any way for any claim for liability that may arise in connection with participation in WOC 2023 or in any other official training activities. All participants take part at their own risk and are responsible for arranging their own insurance cover (illness and accident).

SIAC-cards

SIAC-cards will be provided by the organizer.

Climate & Hazards

July is the warmest month of the year in Switzerland. Daytime average temperatures in Flims Laax in July fall between 10 and 22° C. Maximum temperatures of up to 30° C are rare, but possible. In summer, sudden showers or thunderstorms may occur, mostly during the afternoon and evening. As the competition areas are at an altitude between 800 and 2000 m, major temperature differences are possible even within one competition day. Wild bees and similar may possibly be encountered in the competition areas. Full arms and leg cover is recommended in order to avoid tick bites in the forest. Ticks can transmit Lyme disease and Meningoencephalitis.

Visa

A valid passport is required for entry into Switzerland. Travellers from specific countries may require a visa or further documents in order to be allowed entry.

Athlete Licence

All participating athletes need a valid IOF Athlete Licence. To obtain a valid licence, the athlete needs to sign an athlete licence form and pay an annual fee of EUR 40.-. Medal Ceremonies

The best six athletes/teams in the individual final races/relay will be honoured at an atmospheric medal ceremony in the evening of the race days at 20:00. These ceremonies will take place at the Medal Plaza in the rocksresort in the heart of the athletes' village and will be accompanied by a concert.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

Punching and Timing Punching system

Touch-free SPORTident Air+ punching will be used. Participants will be provided with an SIAC-card by the organizer.

Timing system

Middle Qualification: at the start beep, the competitor will be released by an official who is removing a hand from the map. The listed start times will be used.

Middle and Long Final: a start gate will be used. The timing of an athlete starts when the athlete opens the gate with his/her legs.

Relay: the start signal will be given by the start official.

At finish, the time is taken when the athlete's chest crosses the finish line. There is no punching at the finish line. The running times are rounded down to full seconds.

GPS Tracking

GPS tracking services will be provided for all competitors in all races. It is mandatory for all runners to wear the GPS-unit. Personal GPS data loggers will only be permitted if they have no display or audible feedback. No GPS watches are allowed. There will be checks at the start.

Clothing and Footwear

There are no regulations on clothing. Shoes with spikes are not allowed in all races, however, dobb spikes are allowed.

Starting groups and Start Interval

The starting groups will be based on the IOF Competition Rules. Start Interval at the Middle Qualification and Middle Final: 2 minutes. Start interval at the Long Final: 3 minutes.

Terrain description

Long Distance

Terrain

The mountainous terrain is dominated by steep slopes, deep stream systems and ditches changing to moderate hills with more rounded forms. The terrain is also affected by the largest landslide ever seen in the Alps.

Beautiful views from the alpine and pre-alpine terrain will change to steep slopes varying with a lot of contour details, rocks and cliffs at 1000–2000 m above sea level. The slopes will have both tough uphill and downhill passages. Be ready for a physical challenge in mountainous surroundings.

Forms

Moderate to steep slopes. Detailed contours vary with slopes with few details.

Vegetation

Alpine, open and semi-open pine forest, meadows and grassland.

Runnability

Good to very good runnability with some undergrowth and stony parts.

Middle Qualification and Final, Relay

Terrain

The terrain is affected by the largest landslide ever seen in the Alps. Pre-alpine terrain with countless contour details, forms and rock formations at 800-1500 m above sea level. Most slopes are moderate, some are steep and certainly with breathtaking views. The detailed, complex contours and the countless rock details require accurate map reading. Magical moments are certain when navigating around hills, depressions or boulders and seeing the control exactly where you expect it to be!

Vegetation

Pre-alpine, open and semi-open forest, mostly pine forest.



ENVIRONMENTAL CONCEPT

WOC 2023 in Flims Laax and the Swiss Orienteering Week will take place in one of the most beautiful areas in the mountain canton of Graubünden. It is the impressive mountain formations that border the competition area in the north, the Rhine Gorge, which wildly and inaccessibly limits the competition maps in the south, and the unique flora and fauna in the forests and on the lakes in and around the area in which the competitions will take place, that provide the unique setting for these events. The attractiveness of the region attracts many tourists in both winter and summer. Good planning and management of visitor activities is necessary in order to reconcile the needs of tourism with the protection requirements of the ecosystems. The Flims Laax region does a lot to manage the region sustainably and has developed its own green style environmental charter for this purpose. Therefore, the events and all the participants are not automatically welcome in the region during the two weeks in July 2023. In order for the orienteering events to be carried out sustainably in this ecologically valuable area, careful planning and a lot of work is also necessary on the part of the organizers.

WOC 2023



A comprehensive environmental concept has therefore been developed for the WOC 2023/ SOW 2023. It describes measures regarding permits, agreements and communication, waste, littering and noise, material, traffic, transport, energy and infrastructure, as well as nature and landscape.

A special characteristic of the World Orienteering Championships/Swiss Orienteering Week 2023 is the compactness of the event. WOC 2023 will use only one finish area for all the main events. The distances between the competition centres and the accommodations are short and mostly accessible by bike or on foot. For longer distances, a well-developed network of public transport is available. The WOC/SOW 2023 will thus become the "World Championships of short distances"!

The overall goal of the environmental concept is to organize attractive competitions without any sustainable impairment to the valuable flora and fauna, and at the same time to demonstrate and provide insight into a future-oriented approach to organizing sustainable major events. The behaviour of all the participants also plays a crucial role in achieving this goal.

WOC 2023

As participants of the WOC 2023, you can contribute to the successful implementation of the environmental concept by adopting specific measures, for example, by adhering to the following principles:



Whenever possible, please use public transportation for your trip to Flims Laax (including your travel to Switzerland). This helps protect the environment, and you won't need your own vehicle once you're here.

During the World Championships, please use the well-developed public transportation system for getting around. You can easily walk or bike between the main competition arena and the Athletes' Village.



Waste disposal

Please use the designated waste bins for the disposal of your waste. In Switzerland, we consistently separate PET from residual waste, even in the finish area. The rocksresort and Peaks Place also have separate collection points for glass, metal, paper and special waste.

During the competition, do not throw away empty power gel tubes or similar items in the forest, but deposit them at a control or official refreshment points.



Landscape and Infrastructure

Use the existing infrastructure appropriately. Use the toilets provided, use the designated parking areas for bicycles and luggage, and respect areas that have "Do Not Enter"-signs, both during the competition in the terrain, and in the arenas.

Report any damage caused to the infrastructure in the terrain (such as damaged fences) at the finish or to the nearest official.

Consider yourselves as guests of this valuable cultural and natural area, behave respectfully, appreciate and enjoy the wonderful landscapes.




