The event will take place in the Vértes Hills, located in the central part of Hungary, 80 kilometres from Budapest, the capital of Hungary. Event Centre will be situated in Várgesztes.

Middle qualification


This will take place at Csákberény, 38 km (35 min of driving) from the Event Centre in Várgesztes.

Middle final & Long distance

These will take place at Csókakő, 43 km (47 min of driving) from the Event Centre in Várgesztes.

Relay

This will take place at Várgesztes (Event Centre).




Transport / Travel Opportunities

Teams are encouraged to use their own transport throughout the whole event. We recommend transport by car/minibus.


The nearest airport is Liszt Ferenc International Airport (Budapest Airport - BUD), which has direct air links to numerous European cities. Located in Budapest - 100 km from Várgesztes, it takes 1h 10min by car to reach Várgesztes by M1 highway.

Another option is Vienna International Airport (VIE) – 180 km from Várgesztes. It takes 1h 45min by car to reach Várgesztes by M1 highway.

The last option is Bratislava Airport (BTS) – 160 km from Várgesztes. It takes 1h 45min by car to reach Várgesztes by M1 highway.

Team Size Entry

The following information shall be given:

- Team manager (chosen from list in IOF Eventor)
- Number of Team athletes (Men and Women)
- Number of Team officials
- Number of Team athletes in the individual races (Federation Quota will be published by the IOF)
- Number of teams for the relays

There is no maximum number of officials per team.



Team Names Entry

The following information shall be given:

- Name of each Team athlete by selecting from federation members in IOF Eventor
- Ordering of rental SIAC cards

Competition Entries

- Names of the athletes and, if required, their starting group, shall be entered in IOF Eventor before 12:00 (noon) on the day before an individual competition.
- Names of the athletes and their running order shall be entered in IOF Eventor before 12:00 (noon) on the day before a relay competition.

Late Entries, Changes of Team Size or Team Names

Late Entries and changes will be accepted, if possible until 15th August 2024 at 12:00. No late entries or changes will be accepted after that date. Late entries and changes will always have a defined extra cost (surcharge).

Entry Changes

- 15th June 7th August 2024 surcharge 20% on new entries, withdrawals receive a 80% refund.
- 7th August 15th August 2024 surcharge 50% on new entries, withdrawals receive a 50% refund.
- After 15th August 2024 12:00 CET no other entries or changes will be accepted.

Name Changes

- 7th August 15th August 2024 surcharge 10 EUR
- Changes of names for competition according to IOF rules, no fee.

Late entries and changes will always be treated equally and must be communicated directly to the organiser on info@eoc2024.hu. The organiser makes the changes in IOF Eventor after deadlines

Notes to the entry fees:

- 1. Accreditation fee covers model events, parking and a set of competition maps.
- 2. For teams where the function of the team official is performed by an athlete, there will be no charge for a team official.
- 3. Middle distance fee contains participation in the model event, qualification and final (either A or B).
- 4. Per person per week. The pre-ordered rental SIAC cards will be handed out in the Event Office as a part of the accreditation. A team manager shall return all rented SIAC cards at the Event office after the last race. Any missing or lost SIAC-card will be charged with a fee 60 EUR. SIAC cards must be ordered with team names entry (7th August 2024).

Payments

After the Team Size deadline (15th June 2024), the organiser will invoice the federation for entries and services. If you need any particular data on your invoice, please write your inquiry before that date to info@eoc2024.hu. The invoices should be paid before Team Names deadline (7th August 2024). If the Federation has done changes after that date, it will be paid/refunded on the event at the Event Office at the latest. All bank costs must be covered by the payer.

6. Accommodation and Food

Accommodation for Teams

The official accommodation is <u>Villapark Várgesztes</u> next to Várgesztes at the same complex as the Event Centre.







<u>Comfort apartment houses</u> can be booked here with wide living room and an open kitchen with every accessories like microwave, a fridge, cooking equipment and a coffee machine. Each house has 4 rooms with 2 beds in each one (maximum capacity: 8 person) and 2 bathrooms. Cars can be parked safely on the parking place next to the house. With the booking of the house you gain access to the <u>wellness pools</u> and the <u>sauna</u>.









Aqua plus apartment houses can also be booked. In these villas everything can be found what is included in the comfort apartment. However downstairs you can find your own wellness section: a 20 square meter heated indoor swimming pool and a Finnish sauna. A wide open kitchen with all kitchen accessories for 8 persons and the lovely living room with leather sofa, LCD TV and a direct exit to the terrace. On the first floor there are 4 bedrooms and a big bathroom with separate shower and bath.

Lunch can be ordered in the restaurant (à la carte).

The organiser has reserved a fixed number of apartments at discounted rates. These must be booked via info@eoc2024.hu. The principle "first-come, first-serve" applies. Latest date for reservation of the official accommodation is **15th May 2024**. After that date we can not guarantee the availability of any house!

There are some hotels, hostels and other accommodation facilities in the area (Mór, Oroszlány, Székesfehérvár). Teams are allowed to book their own accommodation besides the accommodation provided by organisers.

Food

In the quarantine and the team zone in the arenas, we offer refreshments and water. Hot and cold food and drinks will be for sale in the arenas.

Most hotels, restaurants and grocery stores have a variety of food options, also for special diets, vegetarians, and allergy sufferers.

According to the IOF Competition rules (§ 26.5), embargoed areas are forbidden for all potential European Championships 2024 athletes, team officials and other persons, who, through knowledge of the terrain, may influence the results of the competitions. Open Training Camps

1. Open training camp with Autumn Spartacus Cup 2023

Date: 02-07.11.2023

Programme: The training camp will be organised around the Autumn Spartacus Cup. On the competition days, no second training will be held. On the other 4 days, 2 open trainings will be held daily on the official training terrains.

2. Open training camp with Spring Spartacus Cup & CEYOC 2024

Date: 04-09.04.2024

Programme: The training camp will be organised around the Spring Spartacus Cup. On Saturday and Sunday, no training will be held. On the other 3 days, 2 open trainings will be held daily on the official training terrains.

Individual Trainings

Terrain Restrictions

The terrains are generally open for training between 1st April and 31st July.

The terrains are generally not available for training due to the hunting season from 1st August until 31st October.

From 1st November until 31st March the availability depends on a number of stakeholders, please consult us regarding the possibilities.

Night training is generally not possible, please contact us if you would still like to do this kind of training and we will try to find a solution.



Register for a Training

You have to register for training minimum 2 weeks prior to it's date in order for the organiser to request permission!

The application form (Excel) can be found on our <u>website</u>. Please send it back with the necessary data to <u>training@eoc2024.hu</u>

Permission

For every individual training you need a permission from the organisers!

Without a permission it is forbidden to use any of the terrains for orienteering.

We would like to emphasize again, that you have to register for a training minimum 2 weeks before it's date otherwise the permission may not arrive in time.

Courses with Permanent Controls

There are fix courses on various terrains. These will be available from 1st April 2023.

The maps will be published in bad resolution to www.eoc2024.hu. If you want to use these, please contact us on training@eoc2024.hu!

The controls will be marked with a wooden stick in the ground.

These are only visible when you are next to the control site.

Parking Possibilities

We marked the parking possibilities on the <u>embargoed areas map</u> with a blue "P" symbol.

The closed roads are also marked on the map with a red barrier symbol. Please strictly avoid these roads, otherwise you and the organisers may be penalised.





Prices

The following prices are valid only for individual trainings! In open training camps the prices may differ from these and will be determined in the open training camp's own information booklet.

The above prices include a good quality .jpg map files.

The price for OCAD file is 50 EUR/terrain or 300 EUR for all terrains. Each federation (nation) should buy these once. In a joint training each participating federation (nation) should buy the OCAD files.

Examples:

You buy an OCAD file for a terrain and hold 2 trainings for 10-10 people which you print for yourself:

Price: $50 + (10+10) \times 3 = 110 EUR$

You only use maps with permanent controls and hold 3 trainings for 5 people. You also need printing:

Price: $(5+5+5) \times (4+1.5) = 82.5$ EUR

You ask for an organised training for 10 people with 20 controls. You do not need OCAD file but asked for printing:

Price: $10 \times (3+1.5) + (100+5 \times 20) = 245$ EUR

9. Rules and General Information

Competition Rules

The complete rules for the World Cup 2024 consist of:

- IOF Orienteering Competition Rules valid from 2024
- IOF Orienteering World Cup Special Rules for 2024
- National Quota for FootO WOC and World Cup 2024

Latest versions of the Rules are found on the <u>IOF webpage</u>. Runners are awarded World Cup points as per 2024 World Cup Special Rules.

Classes and Participation Restrictions

There are two classes, Women and Men. Participation restrictions, classes and qualification system will follow the World Cup Special Rules for 2024.

Anti-doping

Doping is strictly forbidden, and the organizers of the World Cup are dedicated to supporting the Anti-Doping authorities in their work. Doping controls may be carried out at any time during the competitions in accordance with the procedures described in the WADA International Standard of Testing and Investigations. The latest IOF Anti-Doping rules and the World Anti-Doping Code applies. Athletes who are selected for doping control must bring an official identification (with photo) to the doping test area. The athlete should also present the personal therapeutic use exemption (TUE) if applicable. In general, it is advisable that athletes take their ID to all competitions and events.

Insurance and Liabilities

The organisers decline any liability that might occur through participation in the IOF World Cup Events and Trainings. Each person participates at their own risk and is responsible for their own insurance coverage (illness and accident).

There are no other peculiarities for this event.



Climate and Hazards

August is a warm month in Central Hungary, it brings some of the sunniest days with an average of 13 hours of sunshine. During the Event, temperatures during the day climb to around 27°C and often as high as 30°C, while at nights fall to 15°C. It is a bit cooler in the forest. Average August rainfall is 71.1mm. Expect to see some light to moderate rain and a chance of thunderstorms in the afternoons. August is quite calm with an average wind speed below 10 km/h. Humidity is also low during August.

Ticks, carrying Tick-borne encephalitis and Lyme-disease are present.

VISA

You don't need a visa when entering Hungary if you are a citizen of a European Union country. Other international travellers may be required to hold a Hungarian visa prior to travel to Hungary, depending on your citizenship. For visa waiver agreements, please visit the homepage of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Hungary at https://konzinfo.mfa.gov.hu/en/visa-free-travel-hungary.

Athlete's Licence

All participants need a valid IOF Athlete licence.
To have a valid licence, the athlete needs to sign an athlete licence form and pay an annual fee of 40 EURO. From 2023 and onwards it is a digital process for athlete license that every athlete need to go through every year. Payments of the annual licence fee is done in IOF Eventor, please consult the IOF Eventor Guide regarding this.

Please note that IOF Athlete License holders are for the first time required to complete an e-learning course on Fair Play to have a valid license. The IOF Fair Play Education is available through e-learning courses on education.orienteering.sport.

10. Media Services

Journalists, photographers, camera personnel and social media content creators are welcomed. All registrations will be made in IOF Eventor. Further information, instructions and registration deadlines will be part of Bulletin 3.

A Media Centre is located at the Event Centre. In the arenas, the Media Centres are equipped with all the necessary communication facilities. Special access to the terrains may be provided to accredited photographers.

All participants accept, that photos and videos taken of them during the competition can be published in printed or online media.

11. Competition Information

Punching System

SPORTident Air+ punching will be used for all competitions. OWC participants are requested to use a SIAC card provided by the organisers (free of charge) as primary SIAC during the event. The participants requested to use their own SIAC cards as secondary SIAC during the event or they should rent one. The organiser will offer SIAC cards for rent, they can be booked through IOF Eventor as a service with team names entry (7th August 2024).

Detailed punching procedure will be presented in Bulletin 4.

GPS Tracking

In every race, competitors shall carry a GPS tracking device if selected. It has to be carried on the back of the competitor in an elastic harness.

GPS tracking will be used for live TV production, arena production on the big video screen and live on-line transmission.

Detailed information about allocation and picking up the GPS units will be presented in Bulletin 4.

Clothing

There are no regulations regarding clothing. The choice of footwear is free.


