General reminders Sprint Quarantine

- The route to the quarantine is marked with redwhite stripes from EC.
- Entry with BIB number.
- Shelter, water, toilets, bag drop off, warm up map.
- Obligatory route back to the Finish arena for Team Officials. It will be marked with red-white stripes.





General reminders

 Teams to be careful with embargoed areas!!!

- The Check station activates the SI AIR + mode.
- The Finish line deactivates the SI card.
- All competitors, even those who didn't finish the course have to pass the finish line.



Sprint map

- Some passages and walls are not allowed to pass.
- Those will be taped on the terrain where there's a chance to be mistaken with passable ones.



Sprint map

There will be crossing passages on the streets, which will be marked on the terrain with red-white tape. On the map it will be given with symbol 710.100 Crossing point. The sides of the purple bracket on the map are longer and touch the sidewalks which are passable and it is allowed to run on them. Only the car roads are forbidden for crossing and running. It is allowed to pass the car roads only through the passages given in this way.







Sprint map

There will be artificial fences in the terrain and they will be in the same way as on the technical model today.





Disqualification reminders

- No orienteering shoes with metal dobbed spikes are allowed.
- Competitors must not use or carry communication devices that can transmit or receive information, to or from a remote source, between entering the quarantine zone and reaching the finish in a race, unless the equipment is approved by the organiser. GPS-enabled devices (watches etc.) can be carried provided that:
- • they have no map display
- they have no communication capability other than receiving GPS data
- • they are not used for navigation purposes.





 As stated in the Bulletin – no changes in the time for opening and prize giving ceremonies.

 Teams should align 5-10 minutes before the start of the Opening ceremony in front of the EC – Municipality building.

Question 1 - Answer

The bulletin shows a map of the sprint arena with a spectator control in the centre. Is there an arena run through on all courses that hasn't been indicated on the map?

There is only spectator control and no passages.



Question 2 - Answer

Are there artificial fences in the sprint?
Yes - they will be in the same way as on the technical model today.

Are GPS watches (without map display but with bluetooth) allowed?
YES.

3. Is it possible to open the quarantine earlier (Sprint 8:30, Long 8:00)? Unfortunately, NO.



Question 3 - Answer

1. What is the "blue zone" parking?

It's paid parking with SMS or machine and costs 1,20 lv per hour (0,60 eur) Every team have received passes for the cars and when you put them below the front window of the vehicle there will be no problem.



Question 4 - Answer

1. Is the printing and paper of the model event maps the same as in the competition?

The printing will be the same. Paper will be waterproofed.



Question 5 - Answer

 Is the quality of competition-maps the same as the training-maps?

It will be the same.

- •Make sure there's enough toilets at quarantine and start ("everyone goes at the same time").
- Yes, there will be enough toilets.
- •Is there water and / or sportsdrink at quarantine and / or the start?
- Only water.
- •How many punching units will there be at the controls? One unit per control.



- Is it ensured to have people guarding the controls to make sure noone steals / moves the controls? People at every control or how will this be controlled? There will be people at every control
- Will the forbidden areas be marked clearly enough on the map AND in the terrain?

Yes, they will be clearly marked.

- Will the arena passage with the spectator control have a marked route with a passage with fences, or be "totally free" with just a control? Make sure there won't be crashes with public.
- There is only spectator control and no passages.



Question 6 - Answer

1. Will automobile traffic be cut for the sprint?

Yes, it will be controlled and in some parts completely stopped.
