# **Parking**

South of Brösarp municipality.

Directions from road 19 between Kristianstad and Ystad.

#### **Event centre**

Brösarp school. See map at <a href="http://eventor.orienteering.org/Events/Show/5332">http://eventor.orienteering.org/Events/Show/5332</a> Distance from the parking area 700 - 1500 metres.

# Quarantine

Competitors shall go directly from the parking to the quarantine area before start and are not allowed to visit the event centre.

It is not permitted for competitors to enter the embargoed area on Saturday April 9, 7am - 3pm. Road number 9, through Brösarp, and number 19 is allowed to use for transportation to the quarantine.

Late entries will be charged an additional 50% of the normal entry fee, i.e. SEK 405. Last time for late entry is Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> April 20.00

#### Classes

Swedish League for all elit classes. Only W21 and M21 have World Ranking status. Estimated winning times 12-15 minutes.

#### Class selection and start draw order

Subclasses (E2, E3) will be created if number of entries exceeds 70.

#### Reserve runner allocation

Lists with reserve runners will be published on Eventor and in the information tent by the guarantine. Reserve runners will not be allocated in M21E1 and W21E1.

Allocation of reserve runners will be made in the information tent by the quarantine at latest 09.00. Competitors or team officials must attend in person at the arena to claim a place. Runners or leaders who are not present will be skipped.

# Quarantine/runner registration

The quarantine is adjacent to the parking and opens at 8.30 am. Runners are not allowed to visit the arena before registration at the quarantine. Facilities in the quarantine: in-house, toilets, water and a minor catering.

Runners in all elit classes shall be registered in the information tent at the entrance to the quarantine. The runner must have entered the quarantine at the latest at each class first starting time, see the table above. Competitors representing non-Swedish clubs will not be able to enter the quarantine unless their entry fees have been paid.

Team leaders who have visited the arena later than 10:00 am are not allowed to enter the quarantine.

Competitors who are late to the guarantine will not be allowed to start.

Telecommunications equipment or other equipment that makes it possible to follow the competition online may not be used in the quarantine (e.g. internet, telephone).



#### Number bibs

All competitors in W21E, M21E, D20E, H20E, D18E and H18E1 collect their number bibs, with safety pins, after registration at the quarantine.

Bibs shall be worn on the chest and may not be folded or cut in any way. Together with the number bib, a baggage tag is delivered to be set on your bag.

# Bags/clothing

Bags should be marked with the given tag and left in the indicated area at the quarantine for transport to the arena.

Clothing will be transported back to the arena from the start.

# **GPS** tracking

25 runners in each W21E1 and M21E1 shall wear GPS. List of runners selected for GPS tracking will be announced at the quarantine, at the arena and on Eventor. Vests for the GPS unit is handed out at the quarantine, different sizes are available. The GPS unit is handed out at the pre-start.

Runners choosing not to wear an allocated GPS unit will be disqualified. The equipment shall be returned to officials directly after the finish.

# Warm-up area

Adjacent to the guarantine and between the pre-start and start.

# Start procedure

Entrance at pre-start earliest 30 minutes before start. Reset and check the SI-card at the pre-start.

Distance from pre-start to start 2000 metres, follow orange/white tapes and signs. It is not allowed to deviate from the marked route.

- 5 minutes before: GPS units are handed out. 400 meter to next time point.
- 2 minutes before: Control description is available. It is also printed on the map.
- 1 minute before: Go to the box with maps
- Start time: Take the map and run.
   It is not allowed to touch the map before the start.

Late arrivals to start are allowed up to a maximum of 5 minutes after the regular start time. The runner is allowed to start when it can be done without disturbing other runners.

# **Competition rules**

SOFT's competition rules apply, except that IOF's competition rules apply for World Ranking Event-points. The runner will be disqualified if the rules are not followed.

Complaints about infringements of competition rules may be submitted at the Swedish League Information tent or directly to the Event coordinators. Protests against the organizers decision shall be submitted in writing at the competition centre or directly to the competition jury.

#### **Clothing**



Competitors shall wear clothing that fully covers the body except for head, neck and arms, according to SOFT's competition rules.

#### Forbidden areas

Private properties and areas marked on the map are forbidden areas.

There are guards in the competition area, infringement merit disqualification.

#### Maximum running time

60 minutes

# **Control description**

Control descriptions are both loose and printed on the map. Maximum size 55x140 mm.

# Map change

Classes M21E and W21E get their courses in two parts. Reverse the map at the alternate control.

# **Punching system/controls**

Sportident. SI-cards 5, 6, 8, 9, 10 and 11 can be used.

Please provide your SI-card number when entering otherwise a rental SI-card will be provided at additional charge of SEK 30. A charge of SEK 600 will be made for the loss or non-return of hire cards. Rental SI-card will be assigned when entering the quarantine.

The SI-card must be emptied and checked by punching the "Töm and Check" units as described in the start procedure.

Controls are marked with an orange/white flag, control code, SI-units and a pin-punch. In parts of the competition area controls are very close to each other(>50 m). Runners are advised to pay extra attention to the control codes.

# Map

Scale 1:5 000 and 2.5 metres equidistance, drawn by Maths Carlsson. Offset-printed. Delivered in plastic bag. Size A4.

# **Terrain description**

Slight to medium hilly urban environment with paved streets. Areas with open fields.



#### **Traffic**

The competition area may have car traffic. It is the responsibility of the competitor to run safely and with consideration.

#### **Toilets**

Toilets at the arena and at the quarantine. No toilets after the pre-start.

#### First aid

First aid will be available at the arena.

#### Shower

Hot shower at the arena. Bags and clothes are collected close to the shower.

# **Catering**

Selected food is available at the arena: Hamburgers, sandwiches, drinks etc.

#### **GPS** tracking

Maps and courses will be available in the GPS tracking service Livelox. You can record your route either with a mobile phone via Livelox app (Observe: E1 classes cannot use the mobile phone for this) or with your GPS clock. More information is available at www.livelox.com or in Eventor.

#### Live sound

Live sound from the arena will be available on the Internet during the competition.



#### **Results**

Preliminary results will be available on the Internet during the competition.

#### **Prizes**

Prize for the top 3 in the elite classes (E1), directly when all E1 classes are finalized.
