

ENTRIES AND ENTRY DEADLINES


The organiser has the right not to allow the participants who did not pay the participation fee to start.

COMPETITION CLASSES

Attendance classes: MN 14, 18, 21, 40, 50. The MN21 competition is a world rankings competition (WRE) and the starting order is determined by the status of the world rankings. Competitors not found in the rankings shall be drawn at the beginning of the starts. The starting interval in all classes is 1 minute.

M race classes can be run by all genders. More information here.

FORMAT DESCRIPTION

The race begins with a qualification, which is a regular sprint from a separate start. The expected winner time is 12 minutes. Qualification is a world rankings competition. 16 men and 16 women are qualified for the finals. The finals are as follows: four quarter-final formations, two semi-final formations and one final. The participants will choose which quarter-final they want to go to. The selection of the composition of the quarter-finals is started by the winner of the qualifier and then selected according to the ranking of the qualifier. If a participant does not participate in the quarter-final membership elections, he or she shall be assigned to the remaining placements by a draw within the limits of the available places.

The quarter-finals, semi-finals and finals are run in formations with four participants each. Two participants cross the distance in one direction and two participants cross the distance in the other. Each finals runner-up (quarter-finals, semi-finals, finals) 1st-placed participant will be able to view a both courses of the two runway options 30 seconds before the start moment, after which it will be necessary to decide within 10 seconds which of the runway options he will run. The participant informs the judge of his or her decision, after which the judge

PUNCHING SYSTEM


SPORTident Air+ punching will be used for competition. It is possible to rent SI Air+ sticks from the organisers for 3€.



distributes the cards to the participants of the final race in order of placements. With a participant with 1st placement, the participant with 4th placement will pass through the same path variant. The second course will be completed by participants with 2nd and 3rd placements. At the moment of start, the judge gives a start signal, after which the participants can look at the map and take up the track. From each quarter-final, the two better participants will get to the semi-finals as follows:

The participants who have finished 3rd in the guarter-finals will divide the 9th to 12th places of the general calculation according to the result of the qualification. Participants who have finished 4th in the guarter-finals will share 13th to 16th place in the overall calculation according to the result of the qualification. Participants who did not start or cancel in the quarter-finals will be placed at the end of the general order when the 9th to 16th places are divided. Two better runners from each semi-final will be in the final. Participants who have finished 3rd in the semi-finals will share 5th and 6th place in the overall calculation according to the result of the qualification. Participants who have finished 4th in the semi-finals will share 7th and 8th place in the overall calculation according to the result of the qualification. Participants who did not start or cancel the semi-finals shall be placed at the end of the general order when the 5th to 8th places are divided. In the finals, the result of the general accounting is obtained according to the results of the finish. The calculation of the results of each competition class is evident from the rankings in the overall calculation and qualification of the final runs. Each participant will receive the result only in their competition class, where they were registered.




STARTS

Entry to the quarantine area closes at 18:00. All competitors have to go through the quarantine before they start, where they can get the start numbers. Competition information, start protocols have been printed in the quarantine area and outdoor toilets are available. In the starting area, there are no tents or other roofs for the competitors provided by the organizer - they should be brought by participants if they wish. The use of mobile phones, computers or any other communication device, as well as obtaining information about the race and

possibility of washing.




RESULTS
