
Norwegian TrailO Festival 2024

Travel distances

Approximately 90 km and 1.5 hour by car from Oslo Airport to Vikersund and 80 km and 1.5 hour by car from Vikersund to Ås. From Ås to the airport is 75 km and 1 hour by car.

From a second airport in the region, Torp Sandefjord airport, south-west of Oslo, the distance by car is approximately 120 km/1.5-2 hrs to both Vikersund and Ås.

Terrain

Clear cut areas (both with and without undergrowth) combined with coniferous forest with mostly high visibility.

Courses

1.3 km, around 32 controls in Elite and around 18 in the A class. Wide gravel trail-road in flat terrain. Only one short moderately steep hill (25 m long with 5 m ascent).
