Venue Bonskeid and Faskally Caravan Park, Pitlochry, PH16 5LD

Date 24th April 2016

Travel information Leave A9 at B8019 junction just north of Pitlochry. Follow B8019 north for 1.6k

to the caravan park on your left

Car parking £1 per car, please park as directed by parking officials

Toilets At Faskally Caravan Park only (not at start)

Entry on the day Blue/green courses - £10, Yellow course - £5. Registration 10:00-12:00

Map 2014 by Stirling Surveys with minor updates. Power lines are removed for clarity.

Map is printed on waterproof paper by BML.

Terrain Mostly very runnable, areas with lower visibility, one steep hill with many crags.

available or may be consulted on race day until after the last Elite start.

Start 1.6km taped route to the start, partly along the B8019. Mostly there is a

pavement or grass verge, but for a short section competitors must travel along the road. Take great care! U16s should be accompanied to the start by a

responsible adult. Signs will be used to warn other road users.

Call up 3 minutes

Warm up area Available adjacent to the start

Finish 1.4km taped route back to the Caravan Park. Partly on pavement alongside the

B8019. Second half is shared with route to start.

Download All competitors must report to download whether completing the course or not.

Control descriptions Available loose at the start (printed only on M/W21 maps)

Map change M/W21, Blue and Green have back-to-back maps

Out of bounds All fields are out of bounds

Hazards Livestock, barbed wire fences, crags, fallen trees, river, other users

Timing system SPORTident

Clothing Competitors must wear clothing that fully covers their torso and legs
