The event center is situated at Søndermølle Kultur og Naturcenter, Vinkelvej 40 8800 Viborg. Denmark. 56.434918, 9.427387





4. Rules

The WMMTBOC 2024 will be organized in accordance with the Orienteering Competition Rules for IOF MTB Orienteering Events 2024.

All Competition Rules for IOF MTBO rules are available here: https://orienteering.sport/mtbo/competition-rules/

Use of cycling helmets is compulsory.

Bicycle must be with the competitor all the time.

Competitor found moving without his/her bicycle will be disqualified.

It is forbidden to use some main roads (Marked with Zig Zag markings on maps). Competitors must follow traffic rules.

WMMTBOC 2024 will follow the International Specification for MTB Orienteering Maps ISMMTBOM 2023



Riding off track


Off-track cutting prohibited completely



It is forbidden to leave the tracks. Exceptions are the samples underneath. Any violation will be punished with disqualification by marshals.



Riding off tracks is allowed in areas with symbol 824, open land (orange)



Riding off tracks is allowed in areas with symbol 826, rough open land (orange with white dots).

The narrow linear trace through the terrain, it is also allowed to ride.



In forested areas, riding off tracks is allowed in areas with symbol 825-1 (white with black dots).

MTB tracks are mapped with grey/black. If MTB tracks are unidirectional, riding direction is marked with purple arrows. The one way direction is only in the section between two crossings and this must be respected.



Violation of these rules may, if done deliberately, result in exclusion from the championships without compensation

All maps are produced in accordance with the IOF SMTBOM 2023. All <u>maps are made</u> by the same mapper Erik Flarup from Navet.

<u>Training: 05-06th of August: Neckelmans and Skrikes plantage</u>

Map scale: 1:7500 contour: 2,5 m.

Training will be open 05 August 1400-1900 and


06 August days 0900-1700.

Controls will be collected at 1700 the 06

August.

Terrain: Varied and mixed forest with a very dense trail network. Mostly flat but with areas with steep and detailed contours. The forest is intensely used by mountain bikers. Tracks, trails and forest roads are generally very fast. Distance from EC: 8 km. 56.478926, 9.411813 There is a mainroad between the two small forest. Be aware of traffic and follow the traffic rules.

Training map will be in your welcome bag.



Model event: 06th of August: Broddingbjerg and Nordic park

Map scale: 1:7500, 1:10000, 1:15000

contour: 2,5 m.

The model event will have an example of the start and a control setup as used in the

competitions from 1200-1600

There will be an open training for newcomers

at this map at 1700-1800. Terrain: Hilly and lots of track.

Distance from EC: 0 m <u>56.435280</u>, <u>9.427781</u> Distance parking-start 100 M. Be aware that you have to cross a mainroad to the start and during the model event.

Model event map will be in your welcome bag.



Mass start 07th of August: Ebeltoft plantage.

Map scale: 1:7500, 1:10000, contour: 2,5 m. *Terrain:* A technical terrain with a dense network of paths and tracks. Hilly terrain with shorter, but in some places steep climbs. *Distance from EC:* 99 km.



Distance event area - start: 50 m.

Max time: 2 hours 30 minutes



Award ceremony Ebeltoft at 1500.

The award ceremony will be in the middle of Ebeltoft at the Maltfabrikken 56.200837, 10.678432. There will be a guarded parking at 56.199661, 10.682444. In your welcome bag there will be an accreditation card. This is your access to the parking and back to your car after the ceremony. The guard will not allow anyone at the parking lot without this accreditation card.

In your welcome bag there will be a small map guiding you from the parking to the award ceremony, that is at the Maltfabrikken 56.200837, 10.678432. Approx 300 m from the parking. We encourage everybody to participate at the award ceremony.

Middle distance 08th August, Hjermind Egekrattet.

Map scale: 1:7500, 1:10000, contour: 2,5 m. Terrain: A technical terrain with a dense network of paths and MTB tracks. Hilly with some urban terrain included. Distance from EC: 21 km.

The competition will cross 2 public roads and there will be marshals. They will not stop the traffic, but help to show the competitor, that the road can be crossed safely. BUT THE TRAFFIC RULES MUST BE FOLLOWED.

Distance parking - event area 300 m. Follow Green/yellow markings. Toilets are situated at the parking area



Sprint distance 09th August, Undallslund plantage.

Map scale: 1:7500, contour: 2,5 m.

Terrain: Varied and mixed forest with a very dense trail network. Mostly flat but with areas with steep and detailed contours. The forest is intensely used by mountain bikers. Tracks, trails and forest roads are generally very fast and easily rideable and a fast-riding purpose built mountain bike trail twists throughout the forest.

Distance from EC: 8 km.

Distance event arena to the start: 400 m follow Red/White/Blue ribbons.

Max time: 90 min





Long distance 10th August, Klosterheden plantage.

Map scale: 1:12500, 1:15000 contour: 2,5 m. Terrain: Varied and mixed forest with a long fast gravel roads and small areas with MTB tracks. Mostly flat but with areas with small steep contours.


Distance from EC: 80 km.

The embargo is in place until after the WMTBOC2024. The areas marked on the map are embargoed for all orienteering activities, unless specifically permitted by the organizers. The embargoed areas are out of bounds for all potential participants and team members, including competitors, team coaches, manager or anyone associated to the team/individual.

Any permission for access into embargoed areas must be requested from the organizers, if needed and <u>before</u> access. This includes also if there are any MTB or other events taking place in the embargoed areas and potential competitors wish to participate. The embargo includes the use of drones in or above the terrain.

7. Time keeping system

SPORTident Air+ will be used in all competitions.

The minimum working range is 150 cm.

All competitors will have to use an ActiveCard (SIAC). Rental will be possible.

8. Classes & participation

WMMTBOC W/M 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90. Two adjacent classes in the same decade will be merged if either or both have fewer than 5 entries. W/M 70 and older keep the 5-year steps independent on registered starters. Participation in WMMTBOC is open to all competitors according to their age classes.

Competitors participate at their own risk. Third party insurance and personal injury insurance is compulsory and shall be the responsibility of each competitor.

The organizer will not hold a meeting for the competitors before the competitions.

It is strongly recommended, that the competitors have read the bulletin #4 before competing.

There will be no bike wash at any of the competitions

12. Climate

Average temperature in July/August is just below 20° C. However, the temperature can go as high as up to 30° C. Mean temperature during nighttime is $13-15^{\circ}$ C. Average rainy days are 14-16 per month. The average precipitation is between 77-91 mm per month.

13. Entry permits (Visas)

Anti-doping information: Doping is forbidden. The IOF Anti-Doping Rules apply to all IOF events and the IOF Council may require doping control procedures to be conducted. It is the responsibility of the competitors to obtain any required therapeutic use exemption (TUE) certificate.

Welcome to the Viborg region, the heart of Jutland!

A visit to Viborg - called the "Heart of Jutland" - is a trip through history, culture and nature. Visitors will find a wonderful mixture of an historical medieval town and beautiful varied countryside. Almost 400 years ago a historian said: "Viborg is like the mother of Jutland". The history of Viborg can be traced back a very long time. Take a walk through the cobbled streets and imagine the bustle of life in the middle.

A modern municipality of growth

The Municipality of Viborg has more than 95,000 citizens. This makes us the 9th largest municipality and a very strong player on the municipal map of Denmark. Furthermore, the city of Viborg is the "capital" of the Region of Mid-Jutland. Viborg is a dynamic, pulsating city, focusing on a good quality of life. The growth in the number of newcomers shows an increasing interest in living, learning and working in Viborg or one of the many small villages located in the beautiful landscape around Viborg. In our own quiet way, we are proud of Viborg today – and we are proud of our history.

The history of Viborg

Viborg is second oldest city in Denmark. The official formation of Viborg started around the year 1000, but the area had been a sacred rallying ground since ancient times. The name "Viborg" is a combination of the Danish words "Wii" - which means sacred - and "borg" - which means hill, i.e.: The sacred hill.

Viborg Cathedral was, after a huge City fire, rebuilt in 1864-1876 as a round-arched Romanesque granite church and is still an impressive feat of construction. Inside you can see huge wall-murals painted by Joakim Skovgaard.

Viborg region has an unusually varied landscape with green woods, deep lakes, dramatic hills and open heath land. In Dollerup Bakker (Hills), you can listen to the bubbling springs all year round and feast your eyes on the glittering Hald Lake. The town of Viborg is slow-paced, yet charming. Viborg citizens are proud of the city's beautiful shop fronts and buildings. They provide an attractive atmosphere and are the framework for an active busy market town, with many pedestrian streets and squares. There are many cafés, small galleries and exciting boutiques with clothes and crafts.

You're about to discover the Viborg region and we look forward to welcoming you! We wish you all a good and eventful World Championships.

During your stay at Viborg we offer the following:

A free guided tour through Viborgs history.

Viborg is one of Denmarks oldest cities with traces all the way back to ancient times. Viborg means "holy mountain".

Traders, warriors, crafstmen, pilgrims and adventurers came walking, riding and running with horses and oxen to take further along the Ancient Road to the major trading places and shrines in the south.

Until the introduction of absolute monarchy in 1660, all Danish kings hailed at the thing in Viborg, and noble gentleman men and Catholic bishops adorned the city with monumental buildings, including the characteristic cathedral with two towers.

Why not visit the Largest Limestone mine in the world?

Welcome to the largest limestone cave in the world. Please set aside at least 2 hours for the visit. During the whole year the temperature stays at 8°, a good reason for bringing warm clothes. The caves are a perfect place for a visit during a rainy day or in a heat wave.



Normally you walk in the caves on your own, but you also have the option of a guided tour to hear about the caves, their history and the bats. The tour has a duration of about 1 hour and must be booked in advance.

Visit the Frigate Jutland
