

Rules

- 12.13 In the relay, the entered teams are given start numbers according to the sequence of their placings in the last relay of the same type in the respective event. Those not being placed in the last respective event are given the subsequent start numbers in alphabetical order of Federation abbreviation. The allocation of the various course combinations to start numbers shall be supervised by the IOF Event Adviser. The allocation shall be kept secret until after the last competitor has started.
- 22.16 In a mass start race the start area must be sufficiently wide and long to provide a fair and safe start for riders. Competitors at the mass start will line up standing over their bikes in rows of 4 to 10, as allowed by the start area. They receive their maps at their bikes 15 seconds before the start. The bike must be stationary and competitors shall keep at least one foot on the ground until the start signal.

The order of competitors in the rows for individual races shall be determined by the IOF World Ranking list as published 10 days before the event. In relays, the order shall be determined by the results of the last World Championships for single sex relays, and by the results of the last Nations Cup for mixed relays. Where more than one team per nation is allowed to start, the order is first determined by the order of nations, then by order of teams within the same nation. (e.g. CZE-1, CZE-2, FRA-1, FRA-2, FIN-1 etc.)
