# SECOND HAND **O-SHOP**

Team Australia has asked for new non accredited team member for Middle and Relay due to health problems of accredited team members.

Due to IOF rule 9.7 "..... Changes may be made to the team names until 12 noon on the day before the first race of the event. After that time, no further changes to the team are allowed under any circumstances." SEA has decided not to allow new non accredited team member to AUS team for Middle.

However for Relay in order to support the team spirit of the competition the AUS has been allowed to complete their 2nd team with non-accredited member and this team will not be placed in result list. AUS has been informed.

Maps are in plastic bags.

Prominent trees (symbols 417, 418) are mapped only in Open land. Rootstocks are not mapped.

## **MAP**

#### **Special symbols:**

- ISOM 531 Prominent man-made feature (black cross)
- = small man-made feature
- ISOM 115 Prominent landform feature (brown triangle) = small platform



## **MAP**

Women: 3.8 km, 145 m climb, 14 controls

Men: 4.8 km, 175 m climb, 19 controls

**Expected winning time: 25 minutes** 

**Maximum running time: 80 minutes** 

## COURSES

Separate control descriptions are handed out in the second start box.

Maximum size 170 x 60 mm.

Control descriptions are printed on the competition map as well.

## CONTROL

## DESC's

Moderately hilly to flat.

Altitude 350 - 500 m above sea level.

Local terrain detail (erosion gullies, remains of mining). Mostly coniferous forest (spruce, pine).

Visibility and runnability are mostly very good.

There are many paths.

## **TERRAIN**

Fences drawn in the map by symbol ISOM 518 Impassable fence are forbidden to cross.

# UNXABLE OBJECTS


Meadow near the village of Hromnice, 49.8612N, 13.4281E.

Parking next to the quarantine - follow the organisers' instructions.

The quarantine is open from 7:45.

Coaches can leave quarantine at any time, but once they have left, they are not allowed to return.

## QUARANTINE



#### **Notice:**

- Beware of the low car underpass on the road near Horní Bříza (49.8554N, 13.3948E) only for vehicles up to 1.8 m high!
- The access from the road (49.8588N, 13.4232E) to the parking is narrow, therefore it will only be possible to arrive until 8:50 (when the quarantine is closing) and leave later.
- The road from Obora to Dobříč passes through the embargoed area. It is forbidden to drive to the arena through Obora.

## QUARANTINE



By signing-in at the quarantine by <u>8:50</u> at the latest.

# CHECK-IN<br/>IN QUAR..

You can use a warm-up map without controls.

You are not allowed to leave the area marked on the warm-up map, the area of the warm-up map is considered as part of the quarantine.

## **WARM-UP**

## MAP

Distance from the quarantine check-in to the quarantine check-out (end of the warm-up map): 600 m, 40 m climb (not marked).

Distance from the quarantine check-out to the start: 800 m, 20 m climb. Marked with blue and white tapes. Don't leave the marked route!

Competitors check-out from the quarantine 15 min before their start time.

Once competitors leave the area of the warm-up map towards the pre-start, they are not allowed to go back to the quarantine.

Coaches are not allowed to follow the athletes beyond the quarantine check-out. Emergency toilets are available at the pre-start.


## **PRE-START**

First start: 9:00

**Estimated last start: 14:48** 

Distance from the start line to the start point: 70 m

## **START**



Only the last control and finish are visible from the arena.

Respect the boundary of the competition area, don't enter the forest.

There is no coaching zone or compulsory arena passage.

## **ARENA**

#### The football field in Dobříč, 49.8814N, 13.4616E

Coaches and non-competing runners can travel by team cars to the arena using the spectator parking near the arena. The same applies to coaches who travel from quarantine to the arena.


The road from Obora to Dobříč passes through the embargoed area. It is forbidden to drive to the arena through Obora.

There is a team zone with a shelter and toilets. It is allowed to cool-down in the team zone, arena or parking area.

### **CLIMBING**

Is climbing calculated on the straight or on the optimal route?

#### **ANSWER:**

It is calculated on the optimal route.

### **EMBARGOED ROAD**

Will the embargoed road Obora - Dobříč be guarded?

**ANSWER:** 

YES.

## RED/WHITE STRIPES

There were red/white tapes in the finish area on the long distance. Is there anything similar to expect on the middle distance?

#### **ANSWER:**

Red/white tapes are used only inside the arena. They should not surprise runners coming to the last control.

### **FODDER RACKS**

There were some fodder racks marked on the model event map. Some other weren't.

Are there going to be all, some or none on the competition map?

#### **ANSWER:**

All fodder racks were mapped, none of them should be missing.

### **EMBARGOED AREAS**

#### **Remark:**

Respect the embargoed area by all means! Even when driving a car.

## **SPECTATOR RACE**

Will the spectator races be run in embargoed area? Are coaches allowed to run the competition?

#### **ANSWER:**

The spectators race on Friday interferes with the embargoed area. The coaches are allowed to run the competition, they are not allowed to leave the map. The maps of the spectators race will be published on the internet.

Do not use the competition map for further trainings.

### **EROSION GULLIES**

There are various erosion symbols on a map. How are they going to be used on the competition map?

#### **ANSWER:**

According to the ISOM. Deepness and width play the role. The mapping style is very similar to the model map (same mapmaker, neighbouring area).
