VENUE | Szárliget, Hungary (50 km west of Budapest)



EMBARGOED

The EOC 2024 embargoed areas are valid also for the Selection Race. According **AREAS** to the IOF Competition rules (§ 26.5), embargoed areas are forbidden for all potential EOC 2024 athletes, team officials and other persons, who, through knowledge of the terrain, may influence the results of the competitions. All embargoed areas are strict embargo.

PUNCHING SYSTEM | SPORTident Air+ punching system will be used. Air+ chips may be rented from the organiser for 3 EUR / runner / day. If your SIAC did not work, you would need to punch the old-fashioned way! If the SI unit did not respond, you would need to use the manual puncher attached to the pole (punch on your map).

There will be orange-white flags on the controls.

Please note that it is **not** possible to use your classic SPORTident chip!

We will use a secondary SIAC, which should be collected in the Event Office before the competition.

TERRAIN DESCRIPTION

The terrain of the competition is the 385 m high Zuppa-top and its surroundings, located in the Transdanubian Mountains. Its near-surface rocks are sediments from the sea that once lay here, i.e. limestone and dolomite. This also determines the relief of the surface. The terrain is technically difficult, with steep, rocky slopes and flat roofs in places, and a dense succession of small ridges and valleys in others. The surface is covered with oak woods, planted pine forests and karst scrub forests, with many clearings and groves in places. The runnability of the forestry cuttings is variable.

PRIZES No prize-giving ceremony will be held, results will be available online.

VISA You don't need a visa when entering Hungary if you are a citizen of a European Union country. Other international travellers may be required to hold a Hungarian visa prior to travel to Hungary, depending on your citizenship. CLIMATE July is a warm month in Central Hungary, it brings some of the sunniest days with an average of 14 hours of sunshine. During the competition, temperatures during the day climb to around 27°C and often as high as 30°C, while at nights fall to 15°C. It is a bit cooler in the forest. Average July rainfall is 40mm. Expect to see some light to moderate rain and a chance of thunderstorms in the afternoons.

INFORMATION ABOUT POSSIBLE HAZARDS

Ticks. Tick-borne infections that occur in Hungary are as follows:

If you encounter any ticks on your body, remove them as soon as possible. If you are concerned about a tick bite or about possible infection, please consult a doctor.

Immunisation against TBE is not considered necessary for EOC 2024 Selection Race.

Lightning may occur during thunderstorms. Try to stay off the hilltops and don't seek shelter under an isolated tree. Note also, that lightning mostly occurs in the afternoons.

In the event of hot weather, remember to increase your fluid intake before, during and after the race to optimise your performance and prevent heatstroke. It is recommended to bring a tent or an umbrella to provide some protection.

WASTE | Please:

- Bring your own cup/bottle, so we can give the refreshment in that!
- Take your waste home with you!

OTHER INFORMATION

- The accompanying competition unfortunately will not be held due to the change of arena!
- The competitions will be organised according to the IOF Competition Rules valid for 2024.
- Competitors participate at their own risk. Insurance against accidents is the responsibility of their Federation or themselves, according to national regulations.
- There will be doctor available on both days.
- In the arena, parking area and on the terrain, it is forbidden to smoke, set campfire or the use of any kind of flame.
- Please leave all places in the order and cleanliness as you found them.
- All participants accept, that photos and videos of them taken during the competition can be published in printed or online media.

The start procedure for the elite categories on day 1 will be similar to the one used at the European Championships 2024.

To this end, all participants will be provided with a number bib, which must be worn on both days of the race! This must be collected by all teams at the time of registration. In case your bib number was lost or damaged, please ask for a new one from the Event Office!

In addition, competitors will receive a secondary SIAC card, which must be worn next to the first one (on the same hand)!

The secondary SIAC card will be provided free of charge by the organisers, but only a normal (finger) strap is available - if you want to attach it in another way (e.g. on the wrist), please make sure you bring your own accessory and attach it properly!

Clothes may be left at the start. They will be transported to the Arena after the last start.

0	Start

The start procedure for the elite categories on day 2 will be similar to the one used at the European Championships 2024.

To this end, all participants will be provided with a number bib, which must be worn on both days of the race! This must be collected by all teams at the time of registration. In case your bib number was lost or damaged, please ask for a new one from the Event Office!

In addition, competitors will receive a secondary SIAC card, which must be worn next to the first one (on the same hand)!

The secondary SIAC card will be provided free of charge by the organizers, but only a normal (finger) strap is available - if you want to attach it in another way (e.g. on the wrist), please make sure you bring your own accessory and attach it properly!

Clothes may be left at the start. They will be transported to the Arena after the last start.

Maps will be printed digitally on waterproof (pretex) paper.

OUT-OF-BOUND

This day there will be a larger Out-of-bounds area (marked with symbol 709) with a AREA fence around it on the terrain. This area must not be entered or crossed!

FINISH The finish will be in the arena.
