



The park is approximately 300m from end to end across both North-South and East-West boundaries. It consists of a dense network of garden paths, shrubs and a maze-alike construction.

Expect high speed running with a need of fast map reading and a test of your micro route choices.

The park is also characterized by a series of ponds and man-made water features within it. Expect about 60:40 mix of paved and grass terrain.

Map is newly surveyed in January 2024. No sample will be provided.

The middle terrain is characterized by gentle undulating hills, whose height differences is not more than 60m. It consists of several shallow hill, complex re-entrants, and a relatively wide valley whose bottoms are flat. The area is covered by planation of teak trees with some undergrowth. Visibility is not high, but forest terrain is runnable. There are very few manmade objects in the forest. Tracks are few with bits of dense vegetations and indistinct paths.

*Due to the accessibility of the terrain, a chartered bus transfer is recommended for this day's race.





Accommodation

Teams may arrange for their own hotel arrangements in the city of Chiang Mai for the duration of the race weekend.

Transport

Getting around from the city to the first day's venue can be easily arranged by private hire cars (using grab app) or local taxis.

For the Middle Terrain, the organizer will arrange a chartered transport (2 way) to get participants in/out from the forest and back to the city. An additional fee (per pax) will apply for this service.

Shuttle Bus Transfer for 15 Sept (Middle Race)

Participants who select the bus transfer on Sunday 15 Sept will have its pickup and drop off from Chiang Mai City Center near the McDonalds outlet at the junction of Loi Kroh Road and Changklan Road. Drop Pin: https://maps.app.goo.gl/eiMtKn8B88fGYyyE7

Price for two-way transfer is 300 baht per person and details will be shared in Bulletin 2.

Clothing

There are no clothing restrictions for Sprint Events. However, for the middle and middle relay, competitors must wear clothing that fully cover their legs.

Shoes with studs / spikes are not permitted for sprint distance. For middle distance, the choice of footwear is free.

Organizers also mandate the addition of a whistle for middle distance.

Climate / hazards

Average 22-32 degree Celsius, with a chance of rain during that time period due in part to the change from rainy to dry season.



Registration Process

- 1. Complete online via website link: Active platform
- 2. Make payment (either by credit card) before the stipulated deadline of Early Bird, Normal and Late Entry. Any payment made after each period's deadline will mean that team is liable for the higher price category.
- 3. Required fields in Eventor are Name of athlete, race class, gender.
