## Competition Classes

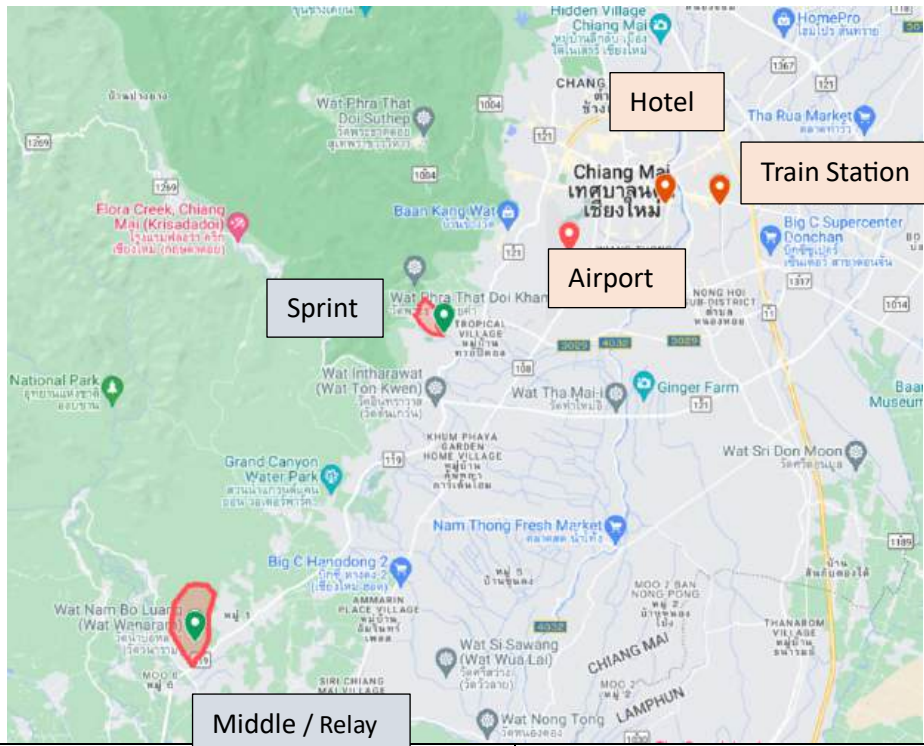

W16 & M16	Up to 16 years old, born in 2008 or after
W18 & M18	Up to 18 years old, born in 2006 or after
W20 & M20	Up to 20 years old, born in 2004 or after
W21E & M21E	No Age Limit

1. No minimum age of participation.
2. In each class, each Federation may enter a maximum of 10 men and 10 women in the M/W21E class and a maximum of 6 men and 6 women in M/W16, M/W18, M/W20 class.
3. The relay is a middle-distance event, and each team shall contain 3 leg runners. In each relay class, each Federation may enter 2 teams in each class but only the better-placed team will be counted in the prize list.
4. Competitors must represent member Federations of the IOF and as defined by the International Olympic Committee as belonging to the Asian continent, can compete in AsOC & AsJYOC.
5. Competitors representing other member Federations of IOF or other Asian countries can participate in AsOC & AsJYOC as Open class but will not be eligible for the AsOC & AsJYOC titles, medals or diplomas.
6. The winners of the M/W21E class will be the Asian Champions of the AsOC. The winners of the M/W20 class will be Asian Junior Champions of the AsJYOC and M/W18 and M/W16 will be the Asian Youth Champions respectively.

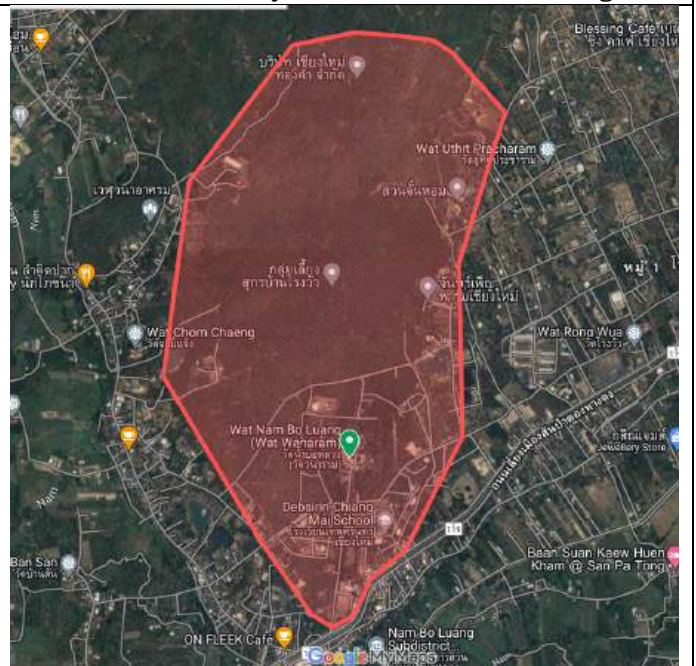




### Sprint Distance @ Royal Rajapruek Park

### Sprint – 22 December 2024 (Sunday)

Sprint: The park is approximately 600m north/south and 700m east/west and is made for the 2006 World Horticultural exhibition. The park consists of network of garden paths, artificial ponds, small hills, buildings, small sculptures, maze like constructions, and shrubs.

It has a good variety of different buildings with multi level and pathways. The running surfaces are primarily paved streets and grass which requires runners to read the map while in high-speed running. The height difference of the competition area is about 30 meters.

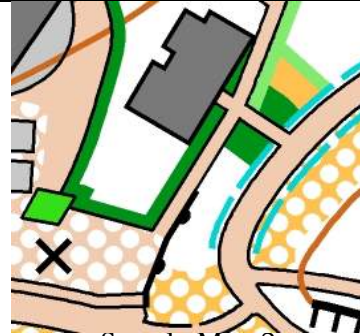
It is also worthy to note that several surfaces may be slippery from gardening in the area.

## Terrain description & Competition maps information

### Middle Distance – 23 December 2024 (Monday)

Middle Event: The terrain is made up of gentle undulating hills, whose height difference is about 60m, consisting of several shallow hill tops, many complex re-entrants, and relatively wide valleys whose bottom are flat. Most part of the forest is runnable with some undergrowth; visibility is relatively high and multiple tracks observed in the area. Man-made features are scarce in this forest and participants should be careful not to venture too far off course.

Venturing into dense vegetation also increases the risk of contact with wildlife and participants should be mindful of their surroundings when doing so. There are, however, several sightings of wild dogs in the area and participants are reminded to avoid direct contact with them where possible.

The organizing committee will do its best to work with local communities to manage the issue and ensure safety of all participants.

Middle Relay: The relay will share the same forested ground as the middle event. However, the area used for the relay event will be skewed toward increasing runnability and flatter terrain conditions. The map area will feature a part of a residential built up area and participants are advised to maintain close map contact as they transit from the forest to urban conditions.

The relay map will feature a different start area from the middle event in the previous race.

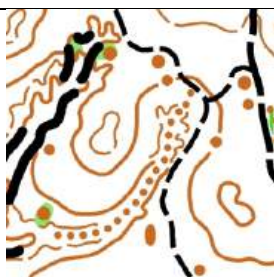

## Punching System

The Sportident AIR+ punching system will be used in all competitions. All cards will be provided for competitors for the duration of the competition. Lost or damaged cards will be chargeable to the federation.



### **Clothing and Footwear**

There are no clothing restrictions for Sprint Events. However, for the middle and relay, competitors must wear clothing that fully cover their lower bodies / legs.

Shoes with studs / spikes are not permitted for sprint events. For middle and relay, the choice of footwear is free.

Organizers also mandate the addition of a whistle for middle and relay.

A race bib will be issued for all events and must be promptly displayed at the front of each competitor.

### **GPS Tracking**

A live GPS tracking device may be provided during the event. More information in Bulletin 3.

### **Competition Rules**

IOF Competition Rules 2024 for Foot Orienteering (including appendix for AsOC and AsJYOC) will apply.

### **Model Event**

There will be a model event held on 21 December 2024 for both the Middle and Sprint distances. The chosen location was previously used for a WRE in September 2024 and is chosen because of its similarity to the actual competition ground. Technical model will also be held at the same place. Transportation will be catered for all participants.

Lunch arrangements for the day will be organized by the teams and it is suggested that teams prepare take-outs or make a detour stop to do so while transiting from the middle to the sprint model venue.
