3. VENUES, ACCESS AND TRANSPORT

The event will be organised at Idre Fjäll which is a year-round resort. Here we can offer long bright summer nights, heather underfoot and beautiful mountains to explore. In addition, we will also offer untouched forests without clear-cut areas. This is the wilderness at its best.

Idre Fjäll is situated in the northwest of the county of Dalarna in Sweden, near the Norwegian border. Stockholm Arlanda Airport is about five hours by car from Idre Fjäll. You can also travel by train from Stockholm Arlanda Airport to Mora. From Gardermoen Oslo Airport is around a four-hour drive to Idre Fjäll. Mora Airport is a domestic airport and from Mora is it approximately a two-hour drive by car or bus.

The Event Centre will be located in the main building at Idre Fjäll - close to accommodation, meeting rooms and restaurants.






5. ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

Team Size Entry (deadline 18 April 2025)

The following information shall be filled in:

- Team manager (Chosen from list in IOF Eventor)
- Number of Team athletes (Men and Women)
- Number of Team officials
- Number of Team athletes in the individual races: Federation Team Quota will be published by the IOF. There is no maximum number of officials per team.

Team Names Entry (deadline 10 June 2025)

The following information must be filled in:

 Name of each Team athlete and official by selecting from federation members in IOF Eventor.

Competition Entries

Names of the competitors and, if required, their starting group, shall be entered in IOF Eventor before 12:00 on the day before the qualification and before 18:00 for the relay.





Late Entries, Changes of Team Size or Team Names

Late Entries and changes will be accepted, if possible, up to the Event start date, 17 June 2025 at 12:00.

No late entries or changes will be accepted after that date. Late entries and changes will always have a defined extra cost (surcharge).

Late entries and changes will always be treated equally and must be communicated directly to the organizer. The organizer makes the changes in IOF Eventor after each deadline.

6.2 ENTRY FEES (UNTIL 18 APRIL 2025)

World Cup Complete Bundle:

SEK 2000 for competitors and SEK 1250 for team officials.

Package includes:

- Starting fees for all competitions (competitors only).
- Training maps and competition maps.
- World Cup dinner night with the ultimate World Cup-Quiz on Friday 20 June 2025



After the Team Size deadline has ended (18 April), the organiser will invoice the federation for entries and services. If you need any specific reference on your invoice, please inform us before this date. All invoices must be paid before 10 June 2025 and any additional bank transfer costs must be covered by the payer.



7.2 ARENA LOCATION

For the Orienteering World Cup, Idre Fjäll 2025, the same arena will be used for all competition days, including qualification and Spectator Events. The competition arena will be located at the lift station - "Ostliften1" at Idre Fjäll (see map above)

9. RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

9.1 COMPETITION RULES

The Competition Rules for IOF Foot Orienteering Events 2025, valid from 1 January 2025 and the Special Rules for the 2025 Orienteering World Cup apply.

9.2 CLASSES AND PARTICIPATION RESTRICTIONS

There are two classes, Women and Men.

Participation restrictions, classes and qualification system will follow the Special Rules for the 2025 World Cup in Orienteering.

9.3 ANTI-DOPING

Doping is strictly forbidden, and the organisers of the World Cup are dedicated to supporting the Anti-Doping authorities in their work. Doping controls may be carried out at any time during the competitions following the procedures described in the WADA International Standard of Testing and Investigations. The IOF Anti-Doping rules and the World Anti-Doping Code 2025 apply as of the 1st of January 2025.

Athletes who are selected for doping control must bring an official identification (with a photo) to the doping test area. The athlete should also bring along their therapeutic use exemption (TUE) if applicable. In general, athletes should bring along their ID to all competitions and events. 9.4 INSURANCE

The organisers disclaim any liability that may arise from participation in Orienteering World Cup races 1 and training sessions. Each person participates at their own risk and is responsible for their insurance coverage (illness and accident).

9.5 CLIMATE

The average daytime temperature in Idre Fjäll in June is between 13-19°C.

9.6 ATHLETE'S LICENCE

All athletes must have an IOF license to participate in World Cup competitions.

11. COMPETITION INFORMATION & TERRAIN

Most of the competition area is within a nature reserve which consists mainly of coniferous forest, no clear-cuts and almost no green areas. Some parts of the terrain are very detailed with many features. The competition area is located at an altitude of 700-900 metres above sea level.

Hilly topography with moderate to steep slopes. Both runnability and visibility are good to very good with few roads and paths in the area. The ground is partly quite stony and rough which will reduce the speed.
