# 3. Venues, access and transport

EOC2025 will be organised in the provinces of Antwerp and Limburg in Belgium.

The nearby international airports are Brussels airport (75km), Charleroi airport (100km) and Eindhoven airport (65km, in the Netherlands).

Brussels airport has a direct rail connection by the Belgian national rail carrier NMBS/SNCB.

There will not be any transport to the competitions organised by the EOC2025 organisation as all sites are reachable by public transport and by car. The EOC races will be held in the cities of **Hasselt, Geel and Lier**.

The official accommodation is in the Radisson Blu Hotel in Hasselt, but teams are free to choose their own accommodation, as long as they are outside of the embargoed areas.



# 4. Event centre Hasselt



## The Event Center of EOC2025 will be in Hasselt in the province of Limburg.

Recognized as the 'City of Taste,' Hasselt places significant emphasis on gastronomy and fashion. Visitors can expect to immerse themselves in the renowned hospitality of the Limburg region.

The Event Office will be conveniently located in the Radisson Blu Hotel in Hasselt. Within the same hotel complex, there is the 4\* Hotel Radisson Blu and a 3\* Hotel Park Inn by Radisson in the adjacent tower. The Radisson Blu Hotel will host the Team Officials meetings.

# 5. Entry

## 5.1. Entries and entry deadlines

### Entries for athletes and team officials

Entries can only be done in IOF Eventor. The entry form will be available from 27 May 2025 on <https://eventor.orienteering.org/Events/Show/7552>

### Timeline

- ▶ The deadline for Team Size Entry is 27 June 2025 (- 2 months)
- ▶ The deadline for Team Names Entry is 17 August 2025 (- 10 days)
- ▶ The deadline for Late Entries, Changes of Team Size or Team Names is 26 August 2025 at 12:00
- ▶ The event start date is 27 August 2025

### Team size entry

The following information shall be entered in IOF Eventor:

- ▶ Team manager (Chosen from list in IOF Eventor, make sure the contact information is up to date)
- ▶ Number of Team athletes (Men and Women)
- ▶ Number of Team Officials
- ▶ Number of Teams for the Relay
- ▶ Number of Start-slots for the individual competitions

There is no maximum number of officials per team.

### Team names entry

The following information shall be entered in IOF Eventor:

- ▶ Name of each Team member by selecting from federation members in IOF Eventor

### Competition entries

Names of the competitors and their running order shall be entered in IOF Eventor, before 12h00 noon on the day before a relay competition.

Names of the competitors and, if required, their starting group, shall be entered in IOF Eventor, before 12h00 noon on the day before an individual competition.

### Late entries, changes of team size or team names

Late entries and changes will be accepted, if possible, up to 26 August 2025 12h00. No late entries or changes will be accepted after that date. Late entries and changes will always have a defined extra cost (surcharge). Late entries and changes will always be treated equally and must be communicated directly to the organiser via [info@eoc2025.be](mailto:info@eoc2025.be).

# Entry deadlines

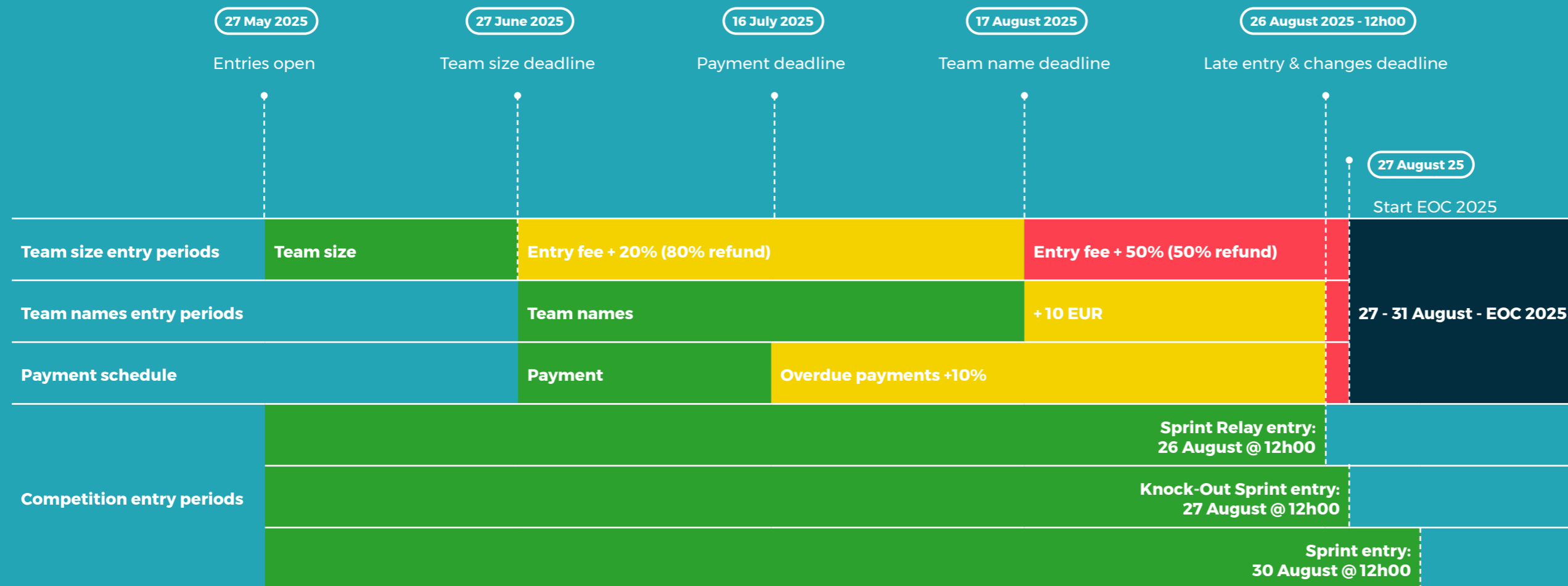
## Late entries/changes extra cost

From -2 months to -10 days: 20% surcharge on new entries, and withdrawals receive an 80% refund.

From -10 days to event start date: 50% surcharge on new entries and withdrawals receive a 50% refund. Name changes in this period cost 10 EURO.

## Payments

After the team size deadline (-2 months), the organiser will invoice the federation for entries and services. The invoices should be paid before 16 July 2025. If the Federation makes changes after that date it will be paid/refunded on the event at the Event Office.



# 5.2. Entry fees

### Notes on entry fees:

- ▶ EOC accreditation fee covers model event and competition maps.
- ▶ EOC accredited team members can take part in an EOC TOUR day course for free upon showing their accreditation at the registration desk of EOC TOUR. Note that it is NOT possible to run the EOC TOUR on Sunday 31 August 2025.
- ▶ For teams where the function of the team official is performed by an athlete, there will be no charge for a team official.



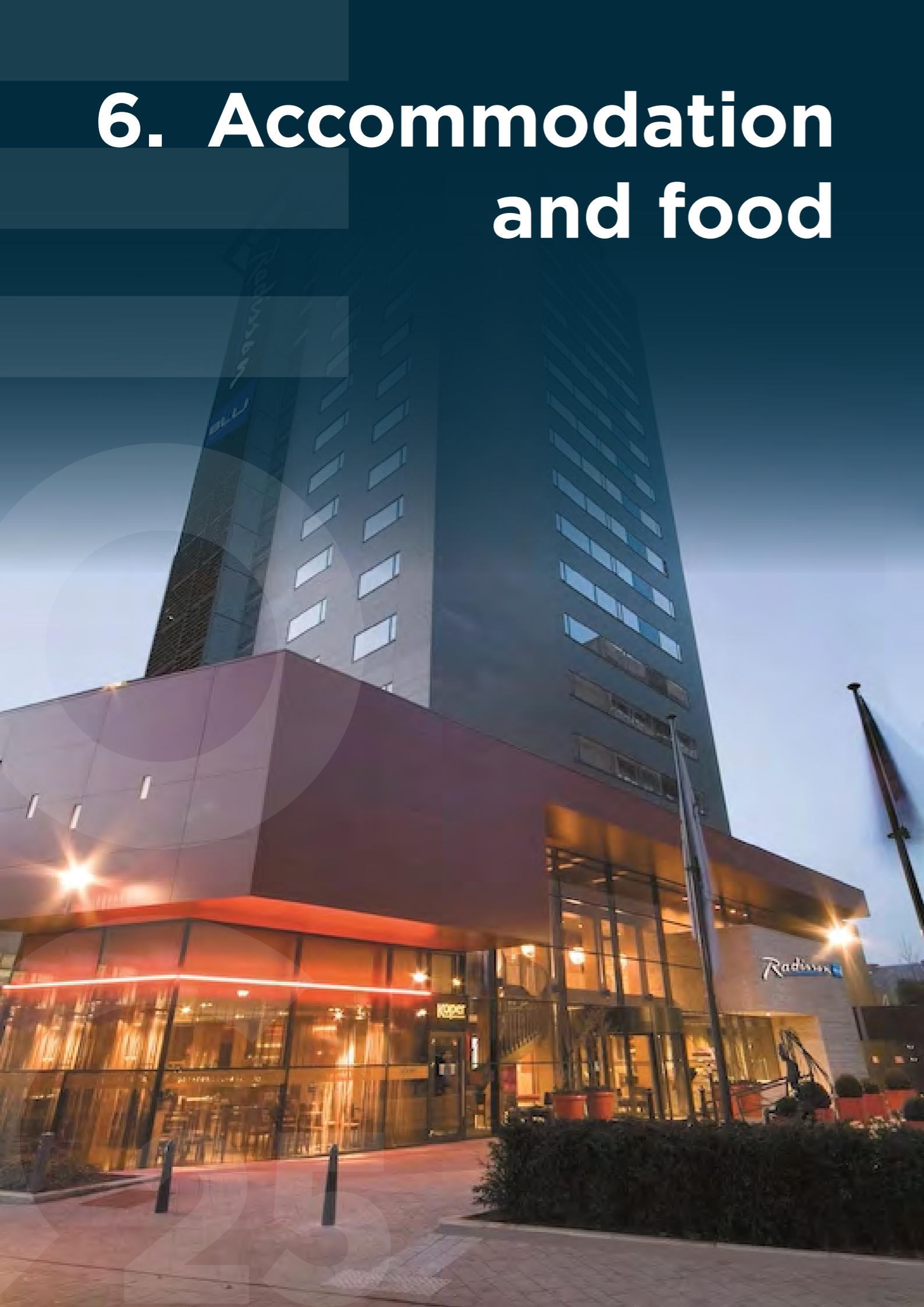

## 6.2. Food

# 7. Embargoed areas



## 7.1. Embargoed areas

The embargoed areas are strictly embargoed. Competitors, team officials, and other persons who, through knowledge of the terrain may influence the results of the competition, are not allowed to enter an embargoed area unless explicitly permitted to do so by the organiser. Any attempt to survey or train with maps on permitted roads in the competition terrains is forbidden. The areas are embargoed until the respective competition is finished.

The map clearly indicates the embargoed zones, highlighted in RED. These areas are strictly off-limits, and no access is permitted.

It's important to note that traveling by train through the embargoed areas is allowed.

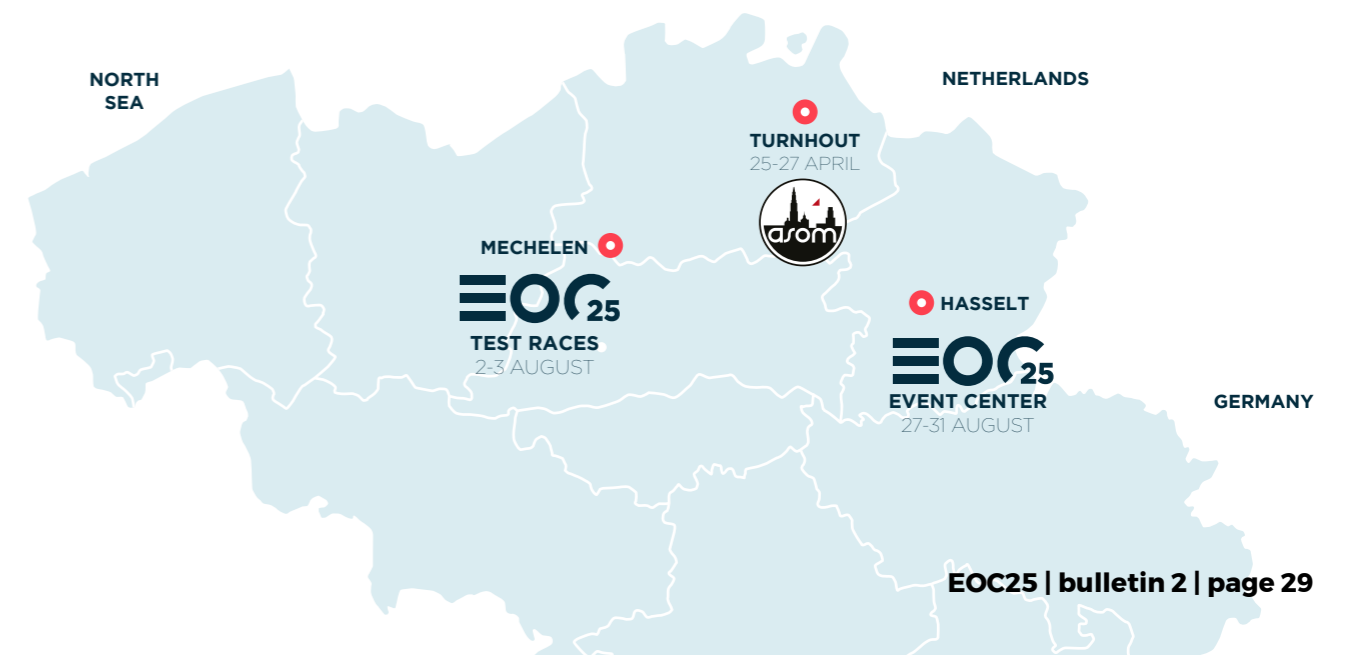

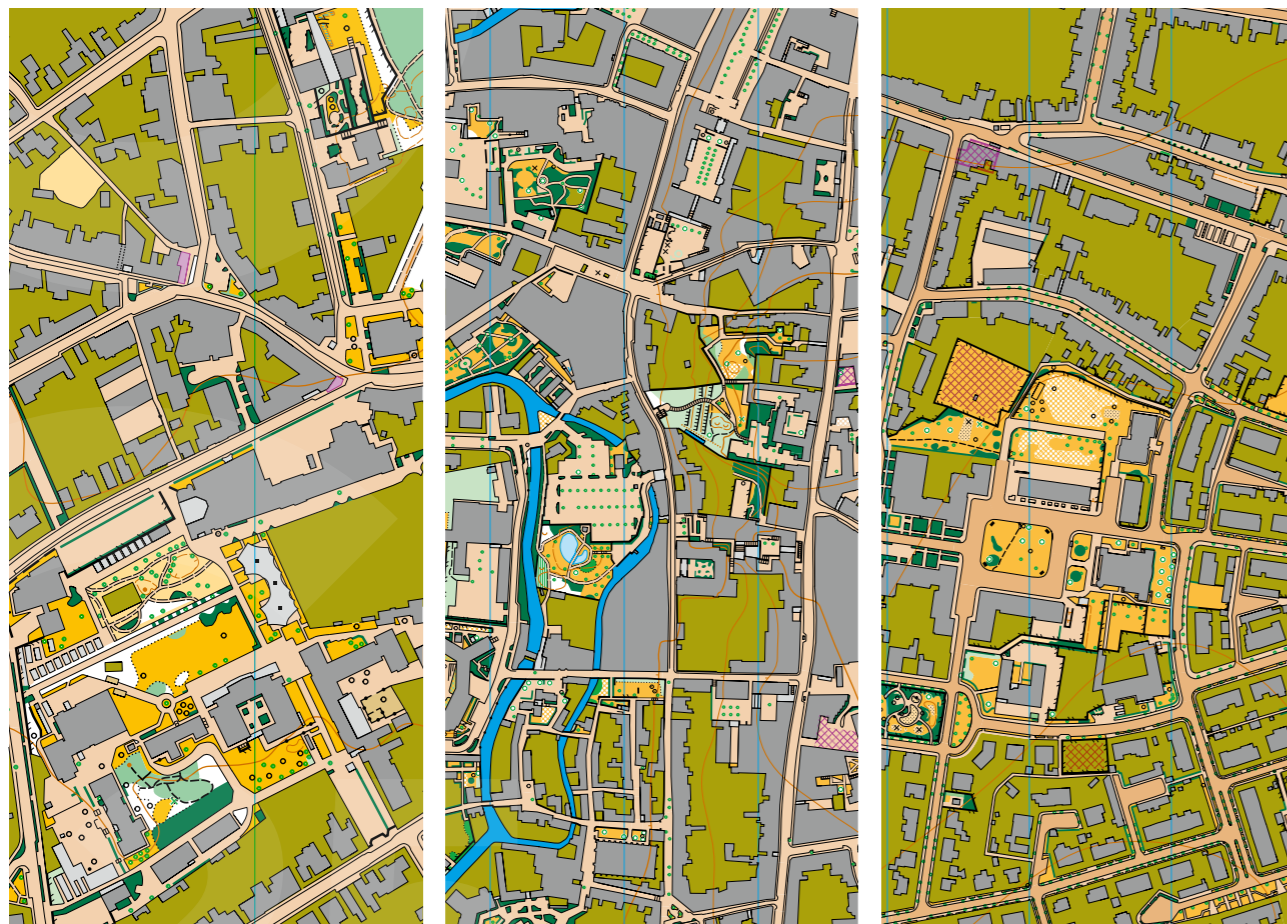

# 9. Rules and general information



## 9.1. Competition rules

The **Competition Rules for IOF Foot Orienteering Events** apply for EOC2025 as well as the **World Cup 2025 Special Rules**.

## 9.2. Classes and participation restrictions

There are two classes; Women and Men.

Participation restrictions, classes and qualification systems will follow the Special Rules for the 2025 World Cup in Orienteering.

- > All competitors must represent a Federation that is a member federation of IOF.
- > All athletes must be full passport-holding citizens of the country they are representing.
- > Athletes being citizens of more than one country, should represent the only country they have run IOF events for during the current calendar year.

## 9.3. Anti-doping

Doping is strictly forbidden, and the organisers of the EOC/World Cup are dedicated to supporting the Anti-Doping authorities in their work. Doping controls may be carried out any time during the competitions in accordance with the procedures described in the WADA International Standard of Testing and Investigations. The IOF Anti-Doping rules and the World Anti-Doping Code 2025 apply as of 1st of January 2025. Athletes who are selected for doping control must bring an official identification (with photo) to the doping test area. The athlete should also present the personal therapeutic use exemption (TUE) if applicable. In general, it is advisable that athletes take their ID to all competitions and events. ## 9.4. Insurance

The organisers decline any liability that might occur through participation in the IOF World Cup Events and trainings. Each person participates at her/his own risk and is responsible for her/his own insurance coverage (illness and accident).

## 9.5. Climate

The month of August marks the end of the meteorological summer in Belgium: temperatures already start to decline. The average daytime temperature in Hasselt at the end of August is between 15°C and 20°C.

There is a moderate probability of rain, and thunderstorms in the evening are a possibility.

## 9.6. Visa

For citizens of the European Union, a valid identity card is a prerequisite for entry into Belgium. Travelers from some countries might require a passport, visa or further documents.

Please check with your local government or Belgian embassy if you need visa permits. More information can be found at the website of [diplomatie Belgium](#) and the website of [immigration office](#).

## 9.7. Athlete's license

All athletes need to have an [IOF athlete's license](#) to participate at the World Cup races.

## 9.8. Medical services in Belgium

First aid services will be provided at the competition arenas.

If you need to contact emergency services (police, fire service, ambulance service), the general emergency number in Belgium is 112.

## 9.9. EOC Banquet & Party

There is an EOC Banquet & farewell party in Lier after the Sprint Final race on Sunday 31st August from 19h00 - 01h00.

Showers & changing rooms will be available to all athletes after the Sprint Qualification and the Sprint Final race.

# 10. Media

Accredited media personnel will have access to a Media Centre nearby the arenas of all finals. Services for media will include:

- ▶ Working facilities including wifi access and electrical power
- ▶ Displays showing broadcast / arena production
- ▶ Maps / start lists / result lists
- ▶ Coffee/tea
- ▶ Managed access to photo / media zones
- ▶ Managed access to mixed zone

All media personnel must be accredited - the process for this will open alongside regular accreditation on 27 May 2025 via IOF Eventor.

# 11. Competition information



## 11.1. Punching system

During the EOC2025 competitions the punching system of SPORTident AIR+ will be used. SIAC's will be provided by the EOC2025 organisation.

## 11.2. GPS tracking

In every race, selected competitors shall carry a GPS tracking device carried on the back in a GPS vest / elastic harness. The GPS trackers will be provided by the EOC2025 organisation.

Please bring your own GPS vest if you have one.

## 11.3. Clothing

Metal spikes or metal dobbed shoes are not allowed. There are no further restrictions on clothing.



# 12. Event information



## 12.1. Sprint relay

### 27 August 2025

A relay race with 2 men and 2 women in each team, running in the following order:  
1) Woman - 2) Man - 3) Man - 4) Woman.

#### Hasselt

The terrain consists of 2 different areas: a typical Flemish city center with a clear city plan and streets in a regular pattern. The second part is a park area with many schools and university campuses. The terrain is completely flat.

- ▶ Winning time: 60 minutes (15 min for each runner)

# 12.2. Knock-out sprint

## 28 & 29 August 2025

The Knock-Out Sprint is a format where 6 runners on a course race head-to-head. The first ones to reach the finish line will go through to the next round.

There is a qualification race on Thursday 28 August. All athletes will be divided in 3 heats, the 12 best of each heat will go to the Quarter Final on Friday.

From each Quarter Final the 3 best runners go through to the Semi Final. From each Semi Final, the 2 best runners go to the Final.

### Geel

The terrain in Geel is very diverse. There is the city center with some big squares and a shopping street. In the area there are numerous schools that take up a lot of space in the city. The schools have big playgrounds and are surrounded by fences. The city of Geel has many small parks.

- ▶ Winning time Knock- Out Sprint Qualification: 8-10 minutes
- ▶ Winning time Knock- Out Sprint Finals: 6-8 minutes

# 12.3. Sprint

## 31 August 2025

This is an individual race with an interval start. In the morning there is a qualification race and in the afternoon the final with the 45 best orienteers from the qualification at the start. The best time of the final course wins the race!

- ▶ Winning time qualification and final: 12-15 minutes.

### Lier

The city of Lier has an old city center. It offers diverse and challenging terrain with narrow, winding alleyways and wider streets. The city has cobblestone streets and market squares. The town has small parks, a river and also the 'Vesten' surrounding the city. The Vesten is a defensive fortification around the city that can still be seen today. It offers a mix of forest, grassy slopes and pathways.
