







# 1. LOCATION

Cēsis is one of the oldest cities in Latvia and a Hanseatic League city. The Amata municipality area abounds in cultural and historical sites and is also a popular region for recreation in Latvia. The area around the Cēsis city is appropriate for the orienteering sport and allows organising high ranking events. The USSR Championships (1983) and a World Cup Stage (1996) took place here. The terrain near the Zvārtes iezis (the Zvarte Rock) will be a real challenge before the World Cup stage in 2017, where similar terrain can be expected. The typical weather in the second part of September is slightly chilly nights and sunny days. The average temperature in September is 11.7° C, with an average high of 8° C and average low of 16° C. About 13-17 days in September usually are rainy.

# 5. CLASES AND ENTRY REGULATIONS

Euromeeting is an open event for national teams in the Elite classes for men (M2IE) and women (W2IE). Euromeeting 2016 will be organised together with the traditional annual orienteering competition "Cēsu rudens". The Elite groups will start before noon. The start order is according to the Rules for IOF World Ranking Events.

### Entry deadlines:

12 September 2016. The deadline for registration (name) and payments

13-19 September 2016. A surcharge of 50% will be applied for late registration.

### 7. TERRAIN AND MAP

### Middle and long distance - Zvārtes iezis.

The terrain is located in the territory of the Gauja River National-Park, on the right bank of the Amata River. Passability from good to medium. Large contour features, pronounced systemsof ravines. Height difference up to 60 m. A medium densityroad and ride network. Dangerous areas – sandstone cliffs at the Amata River banks.

#### Sprint - Cēsis.

The northern part of the Cēsis city. There are family houses, apartment houses and public buildings on the terrain. The map covers a part the Old Town. Height difference 30 m. This area has never been mapped for orienteering purposes.





## 8. EMBARGOED AREAS

All competition areas are embargoed till the competition day.



The middle and long race areas are fully embargoed for the athletes. The sprint race area – it is permitted to visit this area, however, using any maps or doing any training in this area is strictly forbidden.
