In 2027, all members of the World Cup Steering Group will host a World Cup round. The final standings of the World Cup 2027 will then be decided via Sprint races in Tarragona, Catalunya, Spain.


#### WORLD CUP 2027 STARTS IN HÄLSINGLAND, SWEDEN

## WORLD CUP AND EOC IN THUN, SWITZERLAND

It's time for another championship in Switzerland. After EOC 2021 and WOC 2023, the sprint medals at the European Championships will again be awarded in Switzerland.

The three World Cup sprint races will take place in the beautiful city of Thun on the border of Lake Thun. The city is known as the gateway to the Berner Oberland with the touristic spots like Interlaken, Jungfraujoch and Gstaad. Thun is dominated by the castle hill and a beautiful old town beside the shore of the Aare river.

Narrow streets, tough climbs at the castle hill, complex residential areas and fast running parks will challenge the athletes in all of the three sprint disciplines.

And as always in Switzerland: the great audience will make you running even faster to push you to the limit.
