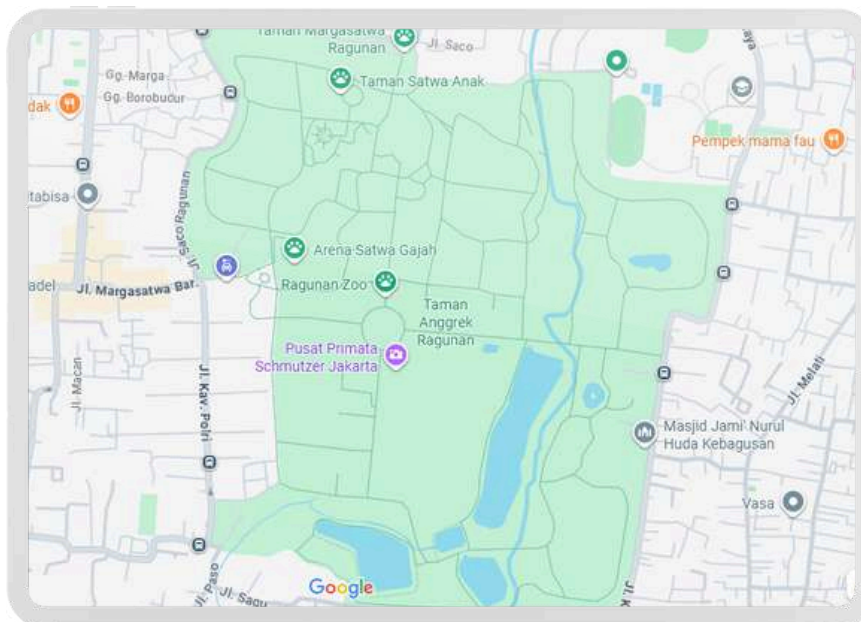

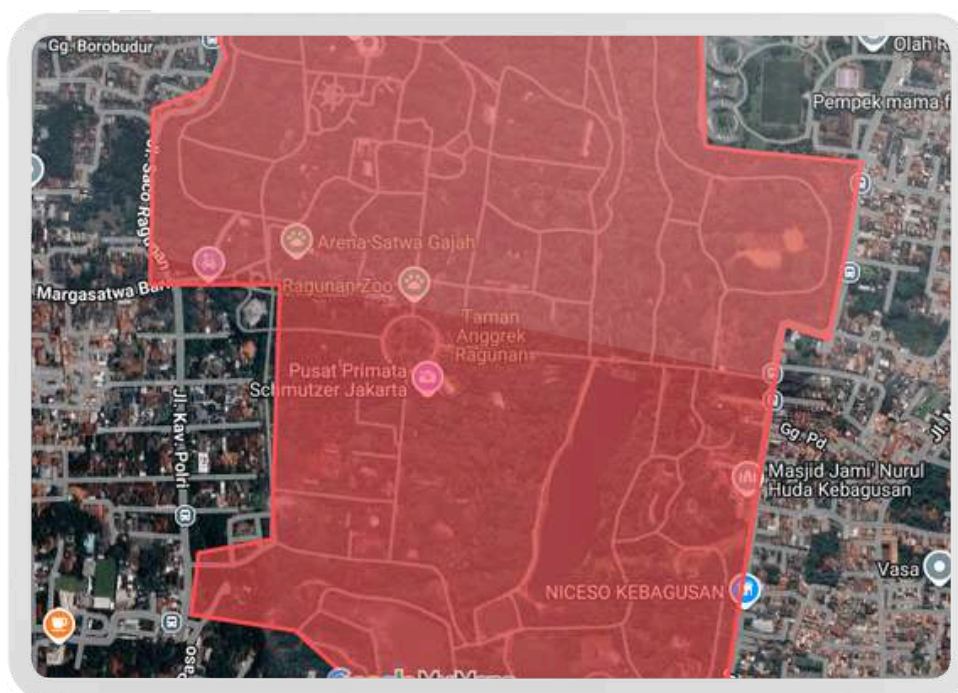

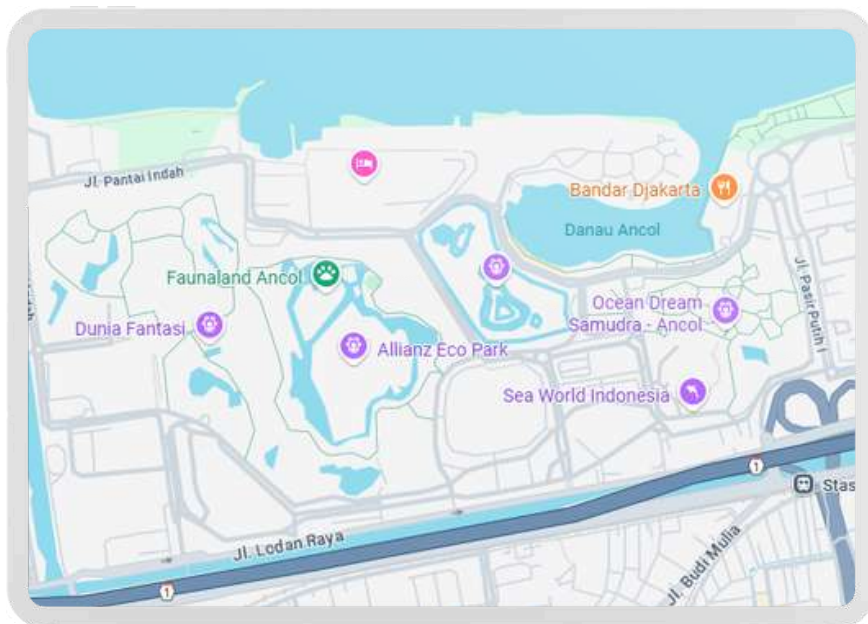
Event Area : Taman Margasatwa Ragunan, Jakarta

The competition terrain is located within Ragunan, a vast urban forest and recreational park in South Jakarta. The area offers a diverse mix of landscapes, combining dense tropical vegetation, open parkland, animal enclosures, and recreational facilities. Runners will encounter a variety of surfaces, from paved paths and sandy trails to grassy fields and compact forest floors. The terrain is generally flat with subtle undulations, making for fast running conditions, though certain sections with thick vegetation and water features may reduce visibility and speed. The park is partly frequented by visitors, so participants should be prepared for urban obstacles, such as fences, buildings, and artificial features, integrated into the mapping. Overall, the venue provides a unique blend of natural and semi-urban terrain, offering both technical navigational challenges and fast route choices suitable for a World Ranking Event. The terrain conditions at Taman Margasatwa Ragunan are designed to provide a diverse and interesting experience for **Orienteers**.

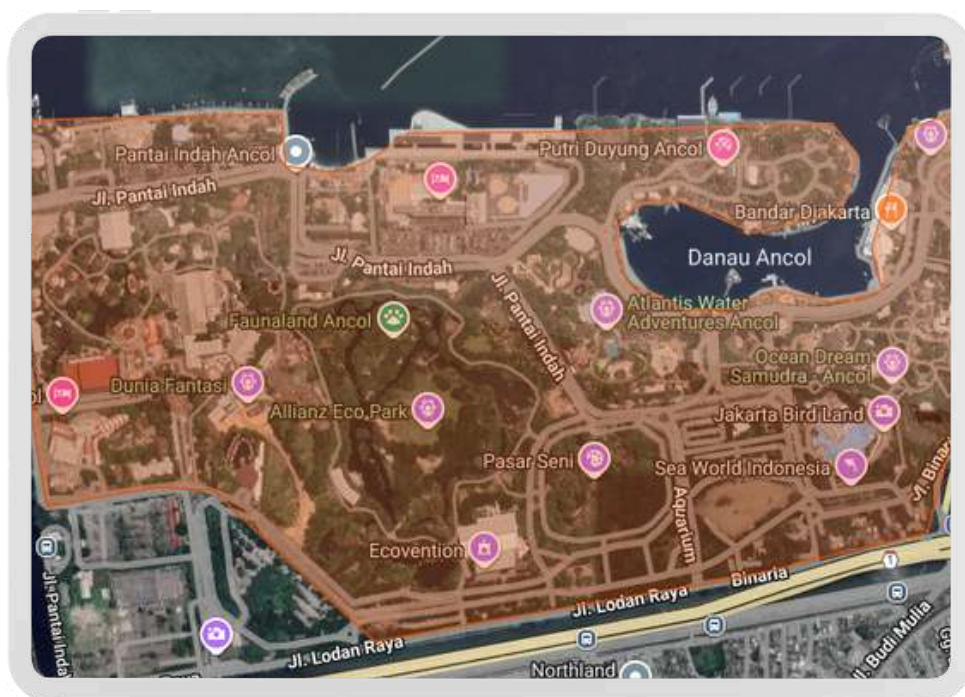

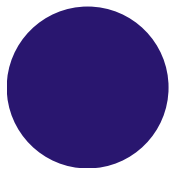

Event Area : Taman Impian Jaya Ancol, Jakarta

The competition terrain at Taman Impian Jaya Ancol features a diverse mix of flat coastal parkland and urban elements, offering fast-paced, highly navigable conditions suitable for sprint and middle-distance orienteering. The area includes a variety of surfaces such as paved walkways, grassy fields, sandy beachfronts, and scattered vegetation, interspersed with buildings, fences, sculptures, and other man-made features. Visibility is generally high, and runability is excellent throughout most of the map, though some sections may present minor obstacles or denser vegetation requiring careful navigation. Competitors should expect a detailed sprint-standard map with precise representation of small features, and must pay attention to clearly marked out-of-bounds areas including water bodies and restricted zones within the active recreational park setting. The terrain conditions at Taman Impian Jaya Ancol are designed to provide a diverse and interesting experience for **Orienteers**.

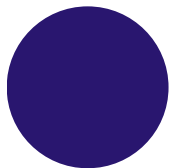

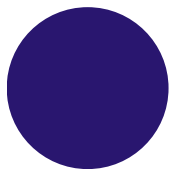

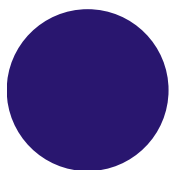
PUNCHING SYSTEM

WORLD RANKING EVENT REGISTER

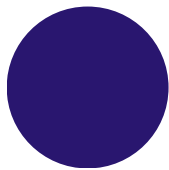

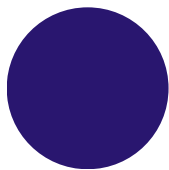

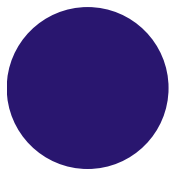
CLIMATE

October is included in the dry season in Jakarta, where the weather tends to be hot and dry. The average temperature is 24°C, while temperatures can reach over 30°C.



CLOTHING

There are no restrictions on the use of clothing. The choice of underwear for orienteering depends on personal preferences and comfort. It is recommended to choose materials that can absorb moisture and have good air circulation so that you can stay dry and comfortable during your activities. Ultimately, choose underwear that allows you to move freely and helps you look your best when you run orienteering.
