

## Rietvlei Zoo Farm – 8 March 2015

### What is Orienteering

Orienteering is a competitive form of land navigation. It is for all ages and degrees of fitness & skill. It provides the suspense and excitement of a treasure hunt. The object of orienteering is to locate control points by using a map and compass to navigate through the area.

### Directions to the Event Centre

From the N12 near Johannesburg (the Southern Bypass), take exit 396 (Kliprivier Drive) and turn right onto R556 / Kliprivier Dr. After 6km, turn left onto Swartkoppies Rd and then after 1.8km, turn left into the Venue. From the R59 highway to Alberton / Vereeniging, take exit 52 and turn west onto the R554 / Swartkoppies Rd. After 3.4km, turn right into the venue.

<b>Mens</b>	Men with some navigation experience, winning time +/- 18 min, 3.6 km	<b>Novice</b>	Easy navigation, suitable for newcomers, ~2km. A fun course not too technically or physically challenging.
<b>Ladies</b>	Ladies with some navigation experience, winning time +/- 18 min, 3.1 km	<b>Kiddies/String</b>	Aimed at young children. Using the map, visit the cartoons and win a sucker, 500m long

**WRE:** This Event is also a World Ranking Event. Competitors wishing to enter for the WRE must pre-enter by 5 March. Organisers / SAOF reserve right of entry to competitors of suitable ability. WRE competitors will have a separate start from 10h30 according to current world rankings.

### Technical Details

<b>Terrain</b>	The Rietvlei Zoo Farm is a mixed environment, with children's play parks, animal enclosures, small ponds, rivers, fields and rocky hillside. The area is used as a venue for a Park Run as well as for mountain biking. Leg protection is advised.
<b>Map</b>	A new drawn to ISOM specification by Ian Bratt, Jan-Feb 2015.
<b>Timing</b>	Electronic punching and timing system (EMIT) will be used to provide for accurate split and finishing times and easy punching.
