From oct 26, 2025 - jan 10. 2026

Only Ormberget stadium, roller ski track, artificial snow tracks, elite tracks and jogging tracks are allowed to visit

NOTE! You are **NOT** allowed to walk on the unlit part of the mile track, Hagaviksvägen (the entire dog track) and the illuminated track from the large triangle junction down towards Lerbäcken/Hertsön. You are therefore not allowed to stay in the terrain or on other paths outside the above-mentioned tracks.

From jan 10. 2026 it is NOT allowed for you to visit the competition area at all









Classes and participation restrictions

WC/JWSOC/EYSOC has different classes: W17, M17, W20, M20, W21, M21

All competitors represent a National Federation. A competitor may represent only one National Federation during any one 12 month period running from November to October. Competitors shall have full passport-holding citizenship of the country of the National Federation they are representing.



WC:

Each Federation may enter a team of an unlimited number of competitors and a number of team officials. Each

Federation may enter up to 6 women and 6 men in each individual competition. In addition, each Federation may enter up to a further 2 women and 2 men, who qualify for the Women U23 and Men U23 classes respectively. In the Relay, each Federation may enter up to 3 teams, each consisting of 2 competitors. Each team must contain at least one woman. Athletes entered to the JWSOC or the EYSOC may complement Relay teams. All competitors must have a valid IOF Athlete Licence. Please ensure that the Athlete Licence fees are paid before the competitions.

JWSOC

Each Federation may enter a team of up to 14 competitors - up to 7 women and up to 7 men - and an unlimited number of team officials. In each individual competition, each Federation may enter up to 6 women and 6 men. In the relay, each Federation may enter up to 2 women's and 2 men's teams, each consisting of 3 team members. If a Federation is unable to make up full relay teams, it may form incomplete teams or teams with competitors from other federations. Under no circumstances may persons, other than competitors entered for the competition, participate in the competition, with the exception of athletes entered to the EYSOC, who may complement JWSOC relay teams.









EYSOC

Competitors representing member Federations of the IOF, defined by the International Olympic Committee as belonging to the European continent, can compete in EYSOC. Competitors representing other member Federations of the IOF can participate in EYSOC but will not be eligible for European titles, medals or diplomas. Each Federation may enter a team of up to 14 competitors - up to 7 women and up to 7men - and an unlimited number of team officials. For each individual competition a Federation may enter a maximum of 6 competitors in each class. In the relay, each Federation may enter up to 2 women's and 2 men's teams, each consisting of 3 team members

Entries

Entries are to be registered by team managers via IOF Eventor.

The following information is required at the latest by December 6 (-2 months):

- 1. Number of participants (men, women).
- 2. Number of relay teams.
- 3. Number of team officials.
- 4. Team manager's name, address, e-mail address and mobile telephone number. This information should also be sent to: Event Secretary info@okrenen.se

The following formation is required at the latest by jan 27, 2026 (-10 days)

- 5. Name and gender (man, woman) of the participants.
- 6. Names of the team officials.

Late Entries

Late entries and changes to registered entries will be possible up until 15.00 (UTC+1) on 6th March 2025. These should be sent directly to the event organizer who will then register the details in IOF Eventor.









Entry fees

The accreditation and entry fees include access to the race venues, the model event, any mandatory transport, SIAC rental, team official meetings and competition maps.
