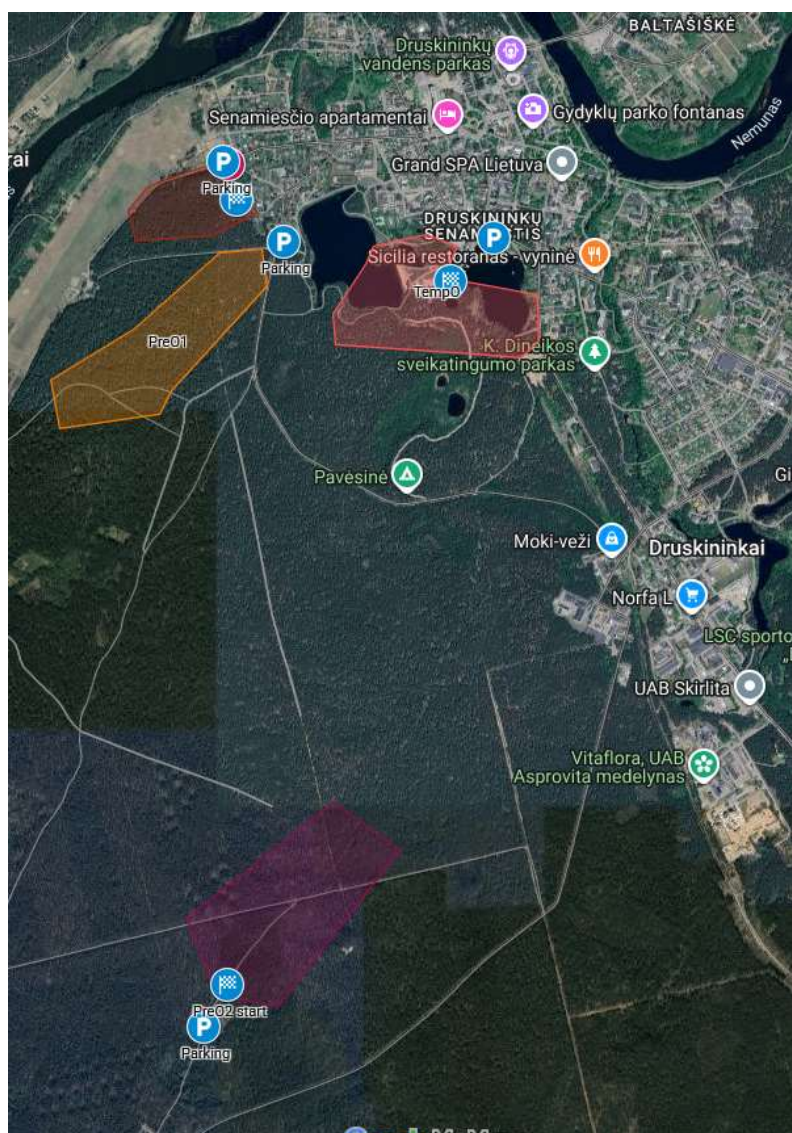

Classes

Results will be calculated in such classes:

Open (O); Physically challenged (PhCh); Junior (J) – *born 2006 and later*. All courses are the same for all these classes.

Easy (A) – more easy tasks for PreO1, PreOSprint and PreO2 courses. This class courses are not WRE. The class will be organized if at least 3 competitors will be registered before 23 March. Otherwise registered competitors will be added to Open class list.

Result calculation and prizes

Falco Cup PreO courses results will be calculated as sum of 2 days PreO courses.

PreO Sprint course results will be calculated as number of right answers if equal - time spent in the course.

Total Falco Cup result will be calculated by the sum of appointed points for the place in each competition.

First 3 competitors in Total PreO and TempO and PreO Sprint courses and all classes will be awarded with event medals.

First 3 competitors in **O**, **PhCh**, and **J** classes will be awarded with Total Falco Cup event cups.

First 3 competitors in **A** class will be awarded with Total Falco Cup prizes.

Late registration will be available with 50% add up till start. Payment will be acceptable in cash at competition event center or by bank transfer (to be received up till 26th of March).

Start lists

Preliminary start lists of all days will be published at 25 March.

Adjusted final start list of each day will be published a day before competition day. Competitors that will be late at their start point or with late registration will have the opportunity to start after published start list ends at free order.

If you need early or late start times – please inform the organizer.

BIB numbers

The competitions will be held without bibs. The numbers will be marked only on back side of maps so please show them to referees before you arrive on any TC/TempO stations for faster and smoother operation.

Assistants

Competitor's own assistants are permitted and welcomed.

Most of paths will be asphalt, except PreOSprint course and first half of PreO1 where it will be forest track used, but in good condition. There will be no helpers from organizers available. No difficult parts for wheelchair users are expected.

Terrain and maps

Mainly brand pine forest terrain with middle and small sized landforms and good visibility for PreO courses. City park with forest inclusions for TempO course.

Terrains maps were used for foot orienteering events. PreO2 and PreOSprint terrains never used for TrailO events. PreO1 and TempO terrains were used for TrailO event at 2016. Latest foot orienteering map of the terrain can be found here:

All maps: 1:3000, contour interval 2,0m, waterproof, mapped at 2025 October-November using Lidar base and will be revised at March 2026 by Andrius Jovaiša. Laser scans are used in mapping process with contours 0.5m. All vegetation objects are precisely mapped. All white areas represent tree canopy (not trunk) configuration.

The map, and solutions will be available only after the last competitor starts and they will be taken over by referees at finish.

Punching

ToePunch system, free for all competitors will be used for registration of answers and for time keeping at PreO1, PreO2 and SprintO competitions.

Punching can be made in free order. All punching stations across the course will be in controls number order mostly at the opposite side of the path.

Result entering in TempO competitions will be organized with mobile devices using **ANT** software and will be duplicated to paper card for competitors.

Answer procedures at TCs:

We would like to save overall time spent on Time Controls so referees will optimize procedures on TCs. They only ask you to choose loose or bound maps. They will expect that competitors will speak answers. When somebody wants to show answers please inform them immediately after arriving on TCs. Referees will show you all six flags and immediately start measuring time after sentence "Time starts now". We expect good visibility of all flags at TCs.

Courses (preliminary)

PreO1 WRE: 1200m, 28-32 controls, 2 time control with 3 tasks in each.

PreO2 WRE: 500m, 32 controls, 2 time controls with 3 tasks in each.

PreOSprint WRE: 290m, 20-22 controls,

TempO WRE: 6 stations with 6 tasks in each, total walking length 1200m.

In most cases decisions should be made by map reading.

Zero tolerance

At least 5 meters for Zero tolerance will be used at all cases with no exception.

All flags more than 100 meters away will be double flagged and at least 8 meters for Zero tolerance will be used for these flags with no exception.

Electronic devices:

The use of other electronic devices is prohibited during the TrailO competition. This is especially true for mobile phones. Violation of this rule leads to disqualification.

Jury:

Will be elected before 1st start and published.

Toilet:

There will be wheelchair accessible toilets.

Accommodation:

We have booked entire "Mineraliniai apartamentai" for the period 27-29 March, where the event center will be.
